Message from the Dean 院長的話



The 2018/19 academic year was another year of hard work and achievements for the College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) and its teaching units - Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) and School of Professional Education and Executive Development (SPEED). I have the pleasure to invite you to read this Annual Report, which summarises our efforts and successes.

CPCE offers multiple study pathways to students and working adults at different stages through HKCC and SPEED. In 2018/19, HKCC and SPEED offered 36 sub-degree programmes and 28 top-up bachelor's honours degree programmes respectively. CPCE's full-time student enrolment totaled over 12,000, making it the largest self-financing tertiary education institution in Hong Kong. HKCC has over 9,400 students, constituting one-fourth of the total number of sub-degree students in the territory. In addition, SPEED also offers a variety of continuing education courses to learners in different stages of their career.

During the year, the articulation and employment rates of our graduates continued to be good. According to the 2018 HKCC Graduate Survey, 2,385 graduates articulated to undergraduate degree studies, representing an articulation rate of 88.2%. Of these graduates, a historic high of around 49% were admitted to the UGC-funded Senior Year places. As for SPEED, results of the 2018 Graduate Employment Survey showed that over 85% of full-time PolyU-SPEED award graduates were in full-time employment within six months after graduation; and around 5% engaged in full-time further studies.

CPCE's teaching quality received due recognition in external quality audit and benchmarking exercises. In 2018, the Quality Audit Council (QAC) under University Grants Committee (UGC) conducted an academic quality audit on PolyU's sub-degree operations, including HKCC's Associate Degree (AD) and Higher Diploma (HD) programmes and SPEED's continuing education courses at sub-degree level. The QAC Audit Report commended PolyU and CPCE for "the sound approach to setting and maintaining academic standards", "the high quality physical learning and e-learning environments", "the outcome-based assessment" and "the comprehensive personal and career development services provided". In the Student Barometer (SB) survey 2018, CPCE received a high overall student satisfaction rate of 89.8%, which is above the Asian benchmark. CPCE also ranked top 3 for various learning elements in the SB survey among students of the 19 participating Asian institutions.

2018/19學年對專業及持續教育學院 (CPCE) 及轄下 教學單位 ── 香港專上學院 (HKCC) 及專業進修 學院(SPEED)來說,繼續是充實的一年。我誠邀大 家閱覽這份年報,分享學院努力的成果。

CPCE诱過HKCC及SPEED為不同階段的升學及在職 人士提供多元進修途徑。於2018/19學年,HKCC 開辦36項副學位課程,SPEED則提供28項榮譽 學士學位銜接課程。CPCE是本港最大規模的自資 高等教育院校,全日制學生人數超過12,000名, 當中HKCC同學逾9,400名,佔全港副學位學生人數 的四分之一。此外,SPEED亦配合在職人士不同 階段的事業發展,提供多元化的持續進修課程。

年內,我們的畢業生保持著理想的升學及就業率。 根據HKCC畢業生升學調查結果,2018年升學率達 88.2%,有2,385名畢業生升讀學士學位課程,其中 約49%入讀政府資助的高年級學士學位課程,創下 歷年新高。另外,2018年SPEED畢業生就業調查結 果顯示,修畢全日制理大專業進修學院學銜課程的 同學當中,逾85%於畢業半年內獲全職聘用,約5% 繼續修讀全日制課程。

CPCE的教學質素,在校外質素保證報告及指標 調查中均獲得肯定。於2018年,大學教育資助 委員會轄下質素保證局為理大副學位課程的營運 進行了嚴謹的評核,評審範圍包括HKCC開辦的 副學士及高級文憑課程,以及SPEED達副學位程度 的持續進修科目。核證報告對理大及CPCE給予 許多正面的評價,包括「在訂立和維持學術水平 方面設有完善方針」、「優質的實體學習和電子 學習環境」、「以成果為本評估作為核心」及「全面 個人和就業發展服務 1。另外,2018年學生指標 調查 (Student Barometer,SB) 結果顯示,CPCE整體 學生滿意度達89.8%,高於亞洲基準。在SB調查的 多項教學相關指標中,CPCE在亞洲19間參與院校中 均排名首三位。

Message from the Dean 院長的話

While CPCE is a teaching-focused institution, research and scholarship are also valued. In 2018/19, three projects, in the areas of hospitality and healthcare, received funding support from the Research Grants Council (RGC)'s Faculty Development Scheme (FDS) and Institutional Development Scheme (IDS). With funding of HK\$2.45 million under the IDS, SPEED established the Centre for Ageing and Healthcare Management Research (CAHMR) in January 2019. The Centre strives to promote awareness and offer solutions to healthcare and ageing issues confronting Hong Kong.

CPCE is committed to strengthening our ties with the industry and professional community. We offer programmes and courses which are closely relevant to industry and community needs, and endeavour to support our students with internship opportunities. In 2018/19, we signed new collaborative agreements with industry partners including Airport Authority Hong Kong (Hong Kong International Aviation Academy), Hong Kong Public Relations Professionals' Association Limited, PCCW Solutions, and the Song Saa Resorts in Cambodia. The collaboration with CLP Power Academy on our BEng (Hons) in Electrical Engineering programme has proven to be very successful. SPEED Career Fair, running for the fifth year in 2019, received wide support from employers.

Since July 2019, academics from HKCC and SPEED have been grouped together under four Divisions – Business and Hospitality Management (BHM), Languages and Communication (LC), Science, Engineering and Health Studies (SEHS), and Social Sciences, Humanities and Design (SSHS). The new structure is expected to enhance HKCC-SPEED cooperation, create critical mass of expertise, and improve overall operational efficiency.

Lastly, I wish to express my thanks to members of the College Council and Advisory Committee for their counsel and continued support over the years. My heartfelt gratitude also goes to everyone at CPCE – our students, our staff, our alumni and our partners. Without them, none of the above-mentioned successes would have been possible.

CPCE以教學為首要任務,同時亦十分注重研究及學術活動。於2018/19年度,我們成功申請到研究資助局的院校發展計劃(IDS)及教員發展計劃(FDS)資助,展開三項有關旅遊、款待及醫療護理的研究計劃。SPEED運用IDS港幣245萬元資助,於2019年1月成立老齡化和醫療管理研究中心,致力提升大眾對香港護理及老齡問題的關注,並提出相關解決方案。

CPCE竭誠與業界及專業團體加強聯繫,藉以開辦緊貼行業及社會需要的課程及科目,並為同學開拓實習機會。於2018/19學年,我們分別與香港機場管理局(香港國際航空學院)、電訊盈科企業方案有限公司、香港公共關係專業人員協會及柬埔寨頌薩私人島嶼酒店等業界夥伴簽署合作協議,而學院與中電學院亦成功落實有關電機工程學(榮譽)工學士學位課程的合作計劃。另外,SPEED繼續獲僱主廣泛支持,連續五年成功舉辦職業博覽。

CPCE於2019年7月起設立了四個學部一工商及款待業管理;語文及傳意:科技、工程及健康;以及社會科學、人文及設計四大範疇。我們預期新架構將鞏固HKCC及SPEED之間的合作,有效匯聚教員的知識及專長,並提升整體營運效率。

最後,我謹藉此機會感謝各位校董會及顧問委員會 成員多年來對學院的支持,給予我們許多寶貴的 建議。我也向CPCE每一位成員一包括同學、 教職員、校友及合作夥伴表達衷心謝意,全賴你們 的支持,CPCE得以創下種種佳績。

Overview of CPCE, HKCC and SPEED 專業及持續教育學院、香港專上學院和專業進修學院

The College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) was founded in 2002 as a self-financing college of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU). CPCE oversees the operations and development of its educational units – Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) and School of Professional Education and Executive Development (SPEED).

CPCE offers a flexible "2+2" articulation pathway so that HKCC graduates, after completing a 2-year AD or HD programme, may articulate to SPEED's 2-year top-up honours degree programmes leading to PolyU-SPEED awards.

In addition, SPEED offers a variety of continuing education courses to learners in different stages of their career.

In 2018/19, HKCC offered 34 AD and HD programmes spanning the domains of arts, science, social sciences, business and the specialised areas of design and health studies. During the year, HKCC introduced two new AD programmes, namely Associate in Chinese Language and Literature and Associate in English for Professional Communication, which address the further education needs of secondary school leavers with keen interests in languages and communication.

As for SPEED, it offered 28 top-up bachelor's honours degree programmes leading to PolyU-SPEED awards in business and other professional areas in 2018/19. New PolyU-SPEED award programmes launched during the year included: the BEng (Hons) in Mechanical Engineering, the BEng (Hons) in Electrical Engineering, and the BA (Hons) in Convention and Event Management.

In relation to the PolyU award top-up bachelor's honours degree programmes offered in collaboration between SPEED and PolyU Faculties/ Departments, the latter had ceased admitting students in 2018/19. Over the past few years, some of these programmes had already been transferred from the PolyU proper to SPEED, and are now offered as PolyU-SPEED award programmes. These continue to provide quality articulation opportunities for sub-degree graduates.

In addition, SPEED continued to offer courses in collaborations with the University of London (UoL) and Northumbria University (NU)'s Newcastle Business School.

2018/19學年,HKCC開辦34項副學士及高級文憑 課程供同學報讀,涵蓋文、理、社、商範疇,也有 設計及健康學專科。年內,HKCC開辦兩項新副 學士課程:中國語言及文學副學士和專業傳意英語 副學士,以配合同學對語文及傳意學科的興趣。 提供相關升學途徑。

同年,SPEED開辦28項理大專業進修學院學銜 的榮譽學十學位銜接課程供同學報讀,涵蓋 商業及其他專業範疇。於2018/19學年推出的 理大專業進修學院學銜課程包括:機械工程學 (榮譽)工學十、電機工程學(榮譽)工學十,以及 會展管理(榮譽)文學士。

至於SPEED與理大學院/學系合辦的理大學銜課程, 所有相關學士學位銜接課程於2018/19學年已停止 收生。過去數年,部分相關課程已從理大本部轉交 予SPEED開辦,繼續為副學位畢業生提供優質的 升學途徑,同學完成課程後將獲頒理大專業進修 學院學銜。

此外, SPEED也與英國倫敦大學(UOL)及諾桑比亞 大學(NU)紐卡素商學院合作開辦課程。

Continuing Education Courses 持續進修課程



In light of the implementation of the new Quality Assurance Framework for Continuing Education (CE) Courses in PolyU in 2018, SPEED reviewed the portfolio and future development of its CE courses. In 2018/19, SPEED obtained approval for offering two new CE courses which would lead to the granting of qualification, namely "Certificate in Service Enhancement in Medical and Healthcare Clinic" at Qualifications Framework (QF) Level 4, and "Certificate in Environmental, Social and Governance Reporting" at QF Level 5.

In addition, the PolyU Department of Chinese and Bilingual Studies continues to offer Applied Learning Chinese (for non-Chinese speaking students) courses via SPEED for the Education Bureau.

In view of the government's enhancement measurement of Continuing Education Fund (CEF) for further funding injection to the scheme as from April 2019, SPEED is planning to further expand its provision of CE courses. The School aims at forging closer collaboration with professional organisations and government departments to address the continuing professional development needs of industry practitioners and business executives.

由2019年4月起,政府為持續進修基金推行優化 措施及額外注資。為此,SPEED計劃進一步開拓 更多持續進修課程,與專業團體及政府部門加強 協作,針對業界人士及行政人員的持續專業發展 需要,提供適切培訓。

Service-Learning 服務學習



Service-Learning (SL) is an experiential learning approach that integrates academic study with meaningful community service and self-reflections to enrich students' learning. SPEED students of full-time top-up bachelor's degree programmes can choose to take a 3-credit SL subject, or a free elective in lieu of the SL subject, as a part of their graduation requirements.

Since the introduction of its first SL subject in 2016/17, SPEED has obtained approval from the PolyU Senate for implementing three additional SL subjects. Through engaging in service learning, students taking these subjects respectively serve the elderly to help them break the digital divide, promote community health, as well as teach primary school students English language.

With the support of PolyU Service-Learning and Leadership Office, SPEED will step up efforts to broaden its SL subject pool in the future.

Sub-degree Programmes of PolyU and CPCE Commended in the **Quality Assurance Council (QAC) Audit Report**


理大及CPCE副學位課程之營運質素 獲質素保證局核證報告肯定

In 2018, the Quality Audit Council (QAC) under University Grants Committee (UGC) went through a rigorous review process on the sub-degree operations of PolyU. The scope covered UGC-funded HD programmes and CE courses delivered at the PolyU proper, the 30 AD programmes and 6 HD programmes offered by HKCC as well as the CE courses offered by SPEED.

The QAC audit report released in June 2019 concluded that the University's sub-degree provision reflected its strategic priorities and mission. Whether within the PolyU proper or the PolyU-affiliated CPCE, there were sound governance, management and quality assurance of sub-degree programmes. There was also consistency in the application of quality assurance policies and procedures. The efforts of PolyU, including CPCE, in various areas were commended as positive features in the audit report. These included the provision of high-quality physical learning and e-learning environments as well as the wide range of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and services oriented to personal and career development.

於2018年,大學教育資助委員會轄下質素保證局 (質保局)為理大副學位課程的營運進行了嚴謹的 評核,範疇涵蓋理大本部的教資會資助高級文憑及 持續進修課程、HKCC30項副學士和6項高級文憑 課程,以及SPEED的持續進修課程。

於2019年6月公布的質素核證報告總括指出,理大 的副學位課程反映該校的策略重點及使命。不論是 理大本部或是理大轄下的CPCE,副學位課程的 管治、管理及質素保證均有效實施,質素保證的 政策亦得以貫徹一致地執行。理大包括CPCE在 多個範疇付出的努力,在核證報告中獲得讚揚 該等工作包括優質的實體學習和電子學習環境 多項聯課和課外活動,以及專為個人及就業發展 而設的服務。



Survey Results of Student Barometer Autumn 2018 2018年秋季學生指標調查結果

CPCE participated in the Student Barometer (SB) exercise for the fourth consecutive year, and its performance continued to compare favourably with global benchmarks in many aspects of students' experience.

The SB Autumn exercise, conducted by the independent research company "i-graduate", is a global survey of students' experience in areas of learning, living, support and arrival. In 2018, CPCE received a high overall student satisfaction rate of 89.8%, which was above the Asian benchmark. The survey among the local students of the participating institutions revealed that:

- In terms of learning elements, CPCE received an average student satisfaction rate of 89.5%, which was above the global and Asian benchmarks. CPCE also ranked top 3 among the 19 participating Asian institutions for good teachers, quality lectures, learning support, programme organisation and class size.
- With respect to career advice from academic staff, CPCE received a student satisfaction rate of 85.5%, which was significantly higher than the global and Asian benchmarks. Additionally, there was an upward trend of satisfaction rate for employability over the years, i.e. from 79% in 2015 to 83.2% in 2018.

CPCE連續四年參與學生指標 (Student Barometer, SB) 調查,與多項顯示學生學習體驗的國際基準 比較,表現持續優秀。

學生指標秋季調查由獨立研究機構i-graduate統籌 和進行,旨在探討全球學生'於學習、校園生活、 學院支援服務和迎新安排的體驗。於2018年, CPCE 整體學生滿意度達89.8%,高於亞洲基準。從參與 院校本地生的調查意見反映,CPCE取得以下成績:

- 學生對教學相關指標的平均滿意度達89.5%, 高於國際及亞洲基準。在亞洲19間參與院校 中,CPCE於講師質素、課堂質素、學習支援、 課程安排及課堂人數的指標中,排名首三位。
- 學生對教員提供的就業諮詢服務,滿意度達 85.5%,明顯高於國際及亞洲基準。另外,在 就業能力方面,學生的滿意度由2015年的79% 上升至2018年的83.2%,反映持續上升的趨勢。





Scholarships, Student Support Funds and Financial Assistance 獎學金、學生培育基金及資助

In 2018/19, the total expenditure made by CPCE (including CSAO, HKCC and SPEED) on student development activities, scholarships and support funds reached HK\$60.6 million. A total of 2,265 places of scholarships and support funds were made available to students and graduates of HKCC and SPEED.

HKCC presented 16 types of scholarships and support funds grouped under three categories, namely "Recognising outstanding performances", "Supporting learning and all-round development" and "Encouraging internationalisation and cultural exchange", to students and graduates.

At SPEED, six types of scholarships and awards were granted to students and graduates with good academic performance and all-round achievements. Besides, sponsorship was also presented to SPEED students for overseas studies or exchange activities.

On 13 October 2018, CSAO organised the first joint scholarship and award presentation ceremony for the students and graduates of HKCC (left photo) and SPEED (right photo).



Articulation and Employment Prospects 升學及就業前景

The encouraging articulation and employment rates achieved by HKCC and SPEED graduates bear testimony to CPCE's quality teaching as well as its relentless efforts in fostering students' whole person development.

HKCC Graduate Articulation Overview HKCC 畢業生升學情況

According to HKCC Graduate Survey 2018, a total of 2,385 graduates articulated to bachelor's degree programmes, representing a high articulation rate of 88.2%. Among those:

- 61.1% (1,458) joined government-funded bachelor's degree programmes, a record high.
- 48.5% (1,156) were admitted to UGC Senior Year Places, also a record high.

Regarding articulation opportunities provided by PolyU, among the 2,385 graduates who articulated into bachelor's degree programmes, 26% were admitted to PolyU award programmes, while 16.5% enrolled on selffinancing PolyU-SPEED award top-up honours degree programmes.

From the first cohort of graduates in 2003 to those in 2018, over 25,200 HKCC graduates have articulated into bachelor's degree studies. This represents a 16-year average articulation rate of 81.5%, which ranks among the highest in Hong Kong.





Collaborations with Industry and Academic Institutions
與業界及院校合作



With close linkage with industry, commerce and professional community, CPCE is committed to keeping its academic staff and students abreast of the latest industry trends, knowledge and practices. Offering a wide network of industry partners and employers, CPCE is dedicated to fostering the career development of students and graduates.

CPCE與工商業及專業界別建立緊密聯繫,讓教員 與學生掌握最新的行業趨勢、知識以及業界慣例 守則。CPCE與業界夥伴和僱主機構建立廣闊的人脈 網絡,有助促進學生及畢業生的未來事業發展。

Work-Integrated Education (WIE) and Internship Programmes 企業實習教育(WIE)及實習計劃

WIE aims at offering students work-based experiences through internship placements in a real workplace environment. Students are given the opportunity to apply what they have learned in the classroom to the workplace, and develop all-round attributes and general competencies.

At SPEED, all full-time students of top-up bachelor's honours degree programmes are normally required to complete 300 hours of WIE as a part of the graduation requirement. At HKCC, WIE or placement is normally a mandatory component of the HD programmes and an elective component of the AD programmes.

SPEED and HKCC have been active in arranging appropriate placements for students. Scholarships and sponsorship are provided for well-performed students to work as interns in Hong Kong, the Chinese mainland or overseas during the summer break or within the semester.

In 2018/19, a total of 355 HKCC students participated in the WIE or creditbased placement. Besides, 131 students took up internships on a non-creditbearing basis. In the same year, SPEED established partnerships with 55 enterprises through its "WIE & Summer Placement Scholarship Programmes" to provide students with scholarships and internship opportunities.

Through participating in internships, students are able to gain work experience in different industries, including advertising and marketing, banking and finance, catering, hotel and tourism, healthcare, real estate, and retail sectors.

During the year, students' internship destinations included Hong Kong, the Chinese mainland, Cambodia, Guam, South Korea and Thailand.

WIE讓同學有機會在真實的工作環境實習,獲取 寶貴的工作經驗。同學能夠將課堂所學的知識應用 到實際的工作環境,並發展多方面技巧和能力。

SPFFD榮譽學十學位銜接課程的全日制學生一般須 於畢業前完成300小時實習訓練。於HKCC,高級 文憑課程一般亦把WIE或實習科目列為必修部分, 於副學士課程則列為選修部分。

SPEED和HKCC積極為同學安排合嫡的實習機會。在 暑假或學期間,同學獲香港、中國內地或海外實習 機會;而表現出色的同學可獲獎學金和贊助金。

2018/19學年, 共有355名HKCC同學參加WIE或 學分制實習。另外,131名同學參加非學分制實習 計劃。同年,SPEED與55間企業成為合作夥伴, 透過「WIE及暑期實習獎學金計劃」,為同學提供 獎學金及實習機會。

參與實習的同學,能夠在不同的行業累積工作 經驗,包括廣告及營銷、銀行及金融、餐飲、酒店 及旅遊、健康護理、房地產及零售業。

年內,同學進行實習工作的地點包括香港、中國 內地、柬埔寨、關島、南韓及泰國。

CPCE's operations are located in the PolyU Hung Hom Bay (HHB) Campus and PolyU West Kowloon (WK) Campus. Both campuses are equipped with comprehensive facilities, including classrooms and lecture theatres, laboratories, libraries, student computer centres, multi-purpose halls and gymnasium, cafeterias and sky gardens. A fitness centre is available on the WK Campus. The well-equipped campuses provide an ideal teaching and learning environment for students and staff.

In the 2018/19 academic year, a number of campus improvement works were carried out to enhance the teaching and learning environment. After the completion of renovation works in the HHB library in 2018, a number of group study rooms and workstations in the WK library were converted into multi-purpose learning areas during the summer break of 2019.

In addition, the establishment of CPCE Project Laboratory for Engineering on the HHB Campus aimed at offering more hands-on training opportunities to students in relevant disciplines.

Promoting e-Learning 促進電子學習

As an initiative to promote integrative e-learning, a new e-Making Studio in WK Student Computer Centre (SCC) will come into service by the 2019/20 academic year. The new facility will provide teachers and students with the software and hardware for the production of audio/video clips and other class materials for blended learning purpose (e.g. massive open online courses). Besides, with the establishment of a 3D Printing Room in the HHB SCC, students of design and engineering programmes can build product prototypes to actualise their design concepts.

In addition, CPCE Information Technology Unit (ITU) has launched the Wi-Fi printing service which enables students to send printing instructions from mobile devices, tablets and notebook computers to 27 designated printers located in the Express Printing Areas, SCCs and libraries of the two campuses.

CPCE is committed to providing an inclusive and barrier-free campus environment for students with special needs. In due alignment with the existing arrangements on the WK Campus, audio indicators have been introduced in the escalators in phases on the HHB Campus in 2019.

In addition, temporary refuge space for the disabled has been set up in the lobby of the fireman's lift on every floor of the two campuses. Other improvement works included the enlargement of the washroom space, and installation of facilities for ritual ablution as well as automatic doors in the accessible washrooms on the UG floors.

CPCE endeavours to maintain a low-carbon and sustainable campus environment, and cultivate a sense of social responsibility among students and staff.

Energy Conservation 節約能源

CPCE participated in the "Automated Demand Response Programme" of the CLP Power Hong Kong Limited for the third year, and it achieved a significant level of reduction in electricity consumption during peak demand periods

In addition, CPCE continued to support the "Charter on External Lighting" organised by Environment Bureau, the "Energy Saving Charter" by Electrical and Mechanical Services Department, the "Hong Kong No Air Con Night" campaign by Green Sense, and the "Earth Hour" environmental action initiated by World Wide Fund for Nature during the year.

As a measure to enhance energy efficiency and promote green buildings, upgrading works were undertaken for the central control management system and the air-conditioning units of the two campuses.

為減低耗電量及推廣綠色建築,兩所校園亦更換 了大樓的中央控制管理系統以及空調機組。



College Governance 學院管治

College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) is a self-financing college founded by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU). CPCE has its own Council which oversees the College's strategic directions and management. Reporting to the PolyU Senate, CPCE's College Board oversees matters relating to the academic development and quality assurance for its constituent units, HKCC and SPEED.

The governance and QA framework, systems and processes of CPCE, including its committee structure as well as the policy and guidelines governing the planning, validation, quality assurance and review processes for academic programmes, are in alignment with PolyU requirements for all Faculties and Departments.

Governance Structure

Committee Structure and Management of CPCE

College Council

The College Council is the governing body of CPCE. Chaired by the PolyU President, its membership comprises Deputy President and Provost, Executive Vice President, Dean of CPCE, and the Director of Finance. Three Senate members of PolyU and three external members appointed by the University President also serve on the Council as members.

College Board

The College Board is responsible for the academic development of CPCE and quality assurance of its programmes and other activities. Chaired by Dean of CPCE, its membership includes staff and student representatives from HKCC and SPFFD

Committees under the College Board

Under the College Board, there are a number of committees looking after various policy/ functional areas. They are the Academic Regulations Committee, Academic Appeals Committee, College Learning and Teaching Committee (CLTC), Course Assessing and Monitoring Committee, General University Requirements Committee, and Research Committee. In addition, the Subjects Committee has been set up since 1 July 2019.

專業及持續教育學院(CPCF)是由香港理工大學 (理大)成立的自資學院,設有校董會統籌學院的管 理及策略發展;另外設有向理大教務委員會負責的 學院院務委員會,專責轄下香港專上學院(HKCC) 及專業進修學院 (SPEED) 兩個學院的學術發展及 質素保證等相關事宜。

CPCE的管治及質素保證架構、制度和程序,包括 學院轄下委員會組織,以及課程規劃、評審、質素 保證及檢討政策和指引,均依循理大為轄下學院和 學系所制定的要求。

(PCF委員會架構及管理

學院校董會

學院校董會是策劃及領導學院發展的管治組織,由 理大校長擔任主席,成員包括常務及學務副校長、 行政副校長、CPCE院長,以及財務總監;其他成員 包括三名理大教務委員會的成員,及三名由校長 委任的校外人士。

學院院務委員會

學院院務委員會專責統籌學院的學術發展及質素 保證等相關事宜,由CPCE院長擔任主席。委員會 成員包括學院講師,以及HKCC和SPEED學生代表。

學院院務委員會轄下委員會

學院院務委員會轄下設有多個委員會,專責處理學 院在不同範疇的政策或職能。它們包括教務規章 委員會、教務申訴委員會、教學委員會、科目評核 及監察委員會、核心課程委員會,以及研究委 員會。此外,科目委員會亦於2019年7月1日成立。

Dean of CPCE and various committees of the Dean

The Dean, as the chief executive of CPCE, is responsible to the Council for the management, conduct and administration of the College. Committees of the Dean are set up to oversee various matters of the College, including campus and campus sustainability, ethics, management, human resources, information and education technology, grievances and appeals, student discipline, staff and student development, Work-Integrated Education, non-local affairs, library, student hostel management, catering services as well as health and safety

CPCE Advisory Committee

The CPCE Advisory Committee offers advice on the strategic direction and development of the College. It also advises CPCE on the scope and nature of its academic programmes, research and other activities in relation to the needs of Hong Kong and the region. The majority of the CPCE Advisory Committee members, including the Chairman and Vice Chairman, are external to PolyU and CPCE.

CPCE Representations at PolyU Committees

CPCE is represented in various PolyU Committees. Dean of CPCE is a member of the Senate, the Academic Planning and Regulations Committee (APRC), the Quality Assurance Committee and the Academic Council. The PolyU LTC (Learning and Teaching Committee) also includes two members representing CPCE, the CLTC Chair who serves as an ex-officio member, and another academic staff nominated by the College Board.

Communication with Staff and Students

Almost all CPCE committees include appointed, nominated or elected staff members to ensure that staff views are adequately represented in academic and other matters of the College. In addition, academic and non-academic staff representatives are elected to join the respective consultative groups which serve as an effective channel for collecting staff opinions in different College policies. The Staff Retreat also serves as a platform for colleagues to express their views and to be kept abreast of the latest College developments.

To ensure that students' voices are heard and they remain well-informed about CPCE's major developments, student representatives sit on a large number of College committees and user groups, such as College Board, College Learning and Teaching Committee, Library Committee, Information and Educational Technology Committee, Student Development Committee, Student Discipline Committee, Student Hostel Management Committee, Catering Committee and Campus User Groups. The composition of various committees at the Unit level also includes student members to facilitate student participation in the affairs of HKCC and SPEED.

CPCE院長及院長轄下委員會

CPCE院長負責一切有關管理、紀律及行政工作, 並向校董會負責。院長轄下設有多個委員會,專責 處理非教務政策事宜,包括校園事務、校園可持續 發展、道德操守、管理、人力資源、資訊及教育科 技、申訴及上訴、學生紀律、教職員和學生發展、 校企協作教育計劃、非本地事務、圖書館、學生宿 舍管理、膳食服務,以及健康及安全。

CPCE顧問委員會

CPCE顧問委員會就學院的策略方向和發展提供 建議,亦會因應香港及地區的需要,為學院不同 範疇及種類的學術課程、研究以至其他活動,提供 意見。CPCE顧問委員會的主席、副主席以至大部分 成員都是校外成員, 並非理大或CPCE人員。

理大轄下委員會的CPCE代表成員

理大轄下多個委員會均有CPCE的代表成員。CPCE 院長是教務委員會、教務策劃及規章委員會、質素 委員會及學術政策委員會的成員。理大教學委員會 亦有兩名CPCE成員,分別是學院教學委員會主席作 為當然成員,以及由學院院務委員會提名的教員。

與教職員及學生的溝通

為確保學院在教學或其他事宜上,能夠充分反映及 考慮員工意見,學院轄下的委員會大多有員工 代表,他們經指派、提名或推選方式加入委員會。 另外,CPCE分別為教學人員和行政人員成立諮詢 小組,教職員可以推選代表出任所屬小組的成員, 讓學院在不同的決策上能夠廣納員工意見。此外, 員工亦能夠藉著教職員退修會,掌握學院的最新 動向,並對學院的發展發表意見。

為讓同學表達意見,以及了解學院的重要發展, 學院多個委員會及小組均有學生代表成員,包括 學院院務委員會、教學委員會、圖書館委員會 資訊及教育科技委員會、學生發展委員會、學生 紀律委員會、學生宿舍管理委員會、膳食委員會以 及校園用戶小組等。另外,HKCC及SPEED轄下委員 會亦包括學生成員,促進學生參與學院事務。

OA Framework

Programme Planning, Validation and Review Processes

All programmes leading to PolyU-SPEED awards at the undergraduate degree level have to go through identical programme planning, validation and review processes as prescribed by PolyU and followed by all other Faculties. As for sub-degree programmes leading to Poly-HKCC or PolyU-SPEED awards, planning approval is delegated by Senate to APRC (with the list of programmes approved presented to Senate for information), while implementation approval lies with Senate.

Approval authority for offering programmes/ courses not leading to PolyU award is delegated by Senate to the CPCE College Board. For programmes offered in collaboration with overseas universities, their QA systems are duly followed.

For continuing education courses leading to qualifications which bear the PolyU name/logo, the approval authority is delegated by Senate to the CPCE College Board if the courses are to be offered by CPCE/SPEED.

2.2 Academic Advisor System

External Academic Advisors are appointed at CPCE on a broad discipline basis. In 2018/19, a total of seven Academic Advisors were appointed for the discipline areas of Business, Communication, Health and Life Sciences, Hotel and Tourism Management, Humanities and Design, Science and Engineering, and Social Sciences. The Academic Advisors give advice, in the relevant discipline, to CPCE Units and Divisions¹, in the areas of quality assurance; academic programmes and subjects; teaching, learning and assessment, etc.

質素保證架構

2.1 課程策劃、評審及檢討程序

所有可獲頒理大專業進修學院學銜的學士學位課程 都必須經過課程策劃、評審及檢討程序,這些 程序由理大明確規定,所有學院必須依循。至於所 有可頒授理大香港專上學院或理大專業進修學院 學銜的副學位課程,教務委員會授權教務策劃及 規章委員會進行策劃審批(獲審批課程列表提交給 教務委員會作參考),其後課程亦須獲教務委員會 通過,方可開辦。

另外,在提供其他非頒授理大學銜的課程/科目 方面,教務委員會授權CPCE學院院務委員會予以 審批。有關學院與海外大學合辦的課程,會依循該 大學的質素保證機制。

在持續進修課程方面,若課程頒授的資歷證明印有 理大名稱/校徽, 並且由CPCE/SPEED開辦, 教務 委員會授權CPCF學院院務委員會予以審批。

2.2 學術顧問制度

CPCE就不同學術範疇委任校外學術顧問。2018/19 年度,學院就工商管理、傳意、健康及生命科學、 酒店及旅遊業管理,以及人文及設計學、科技及 工程,以及社會科學等學術範疇,委任了七名學術 顧問。他們因應各自的學術範疇,向CPCE轄下學院 和學部1提供意見,建議範圍涵蓋質素保證、課程和 科目、教學和評估等。

2.3 Periodic Unit Review, Annual Programme Review, and Annual **Operation Plan**

A Unit Review exercise is undertaken for HKCC and SPEED respectively on a six-year cycle basis. The Unit Review system serves as an instrument for quality enhancement in academic units; and as a major input for future strategic planning, visioning and international benchmarking. A Review Panel, chaired by Dean(PCE) (who also serves as the College Board Chairman), will be formed. Review Panel members will include at least two ad hoc Independent Advisors for the Unit Review to be conducted on a Unit basis, or a minimum of three ad hoc Independent Advisors for the Unit Review to be conducted on CPCE basis, a PolyU internal academic member, and other members if deemed necessary. In addition, a member of PolyU Academic Secretariat will be appointed as an observer with no voting right to the Panel.

HKCC and SPEED also undertake annual programme reviews so as to maintain high academic standards and to ensure that the programmes best suit the learning needs and interests of students. Feedback is obtained from various stakeholders, including students, employers and partner organisations.

HKCC and SPEED are required to submit an Annual Operation Plan (AOP), by the end of November each year, to the CPCE College Board for approval. The AOP allows the Units to review and reflect on their activities of the past academic year. Reports on the annual review of study programmes/ subjects; an account of the new teaching, scholarly and other initiatives being planned for the coming year; and a summary of staffing and other resources requirements, are among the essential items to be included in the AOP. Based on the observations on the AOP, the College Board will advise the Units on improvement action as and where necessary and appropriate.

2.4 Other Channels of External Input to QA System

Other channels of external input to CPCE QA System include appointments of external members from both academic and industrial sectors to the CPCE Advisory Committee; external examiners/advisors for individual programmes; external members on programme validation panels. Furthermore, academic programmes are accredited by professional bodies where appropriate.

In addition, to assure the quality of education offered, the operations and programmes of HKCC and SPEED are subject to external review by the Quality Assurance Council (QAC) of the University Grants Committee (UGC).

2.3 定期部門檢視、年度課程檢討及年度 運作計劃

HKCC和SPEED需要每六年進行一次部門檢視。 這個部門檢視制度可以促使學院提升質素;並為 部門未來的策略和遠景規劃,以及國際基準 引入專業意見。部門檢視小組將由CPCE院長(即 學院院務委員會主席)擔任主席,進行教學單位 (即HKCC或SPEED)的個別部門檢視將包括不少於 兩名臨時聘任的獨立顧問;若進行CPCE (同時包括 HKCC及SPEED) 的綜合部門檢視則需要最少三名 臨時聘任的獨立顧問。另外,部門檢視小組亦包括 一名理大校內教員,並按需要加入其他成員,同時 委任一名理大校務處成員為觀察員。

HKCC和SPEED每年均為課程進行檢討,以確保課程 質素優良,並且切合學生的學習需要和興趣。兩所 學院亦會諮詢學生、僱主及合作團體等持份者的 意見。

另外,HKCC及SPFFD須於每年十一月底前向學院 院務委員會提交一份年度運作計劃,藉此檢討過去 一年的工作。年度運作計劃的主要內容包括:年度 課程檢討、來年在教學、學術及其他活動的計劃, 以及教職員及其他資源的需求。學院院務委員會會 根據年度運作計劃的內容提供意見,或建議學院 採取適當的跟進措施。

外界參與質素保證機制的其他途徑

外界參與CPCE質素保證機制的其他途徑包括委任 學術界及業界人士擔任CPCE顧問委員會校外成員; 個別課程委任校外主考/顧問;委任校外人士擔任 課程評審委員會成員。此外,學術課程會按實際 需要,尋求專業團體認可。

另外,HKCC及SPFFD的運作及課程均需接受大學 教育資助委員會轄下質素保證局的質素核證,以 確保教育質素。



Finance 財務概況

Overview

The College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) is one of the largest self-financing providers of full-time tertiary education in Hong Kong. It is an independent self-financing arm of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) offering programmes through two subsidiaries of PolyU, namely Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) and College of Professional and Continuing Education Limited (CPCE Limited). CPCE Limited includes the School of Professional Education and Executive Development (SPEED) and CPCE supporting offices. HKCC and SPEED mainly offer a variety of sub-degree and top-up honors degree programmes; they provided quality tertiary education opportunities for around 12,000 full-time students in the 2018/19 academic year. CPCE continued to maintain a wide range of continuing education programmes to cater for the different needs of the community.

CPCE's financial performance in 2018/19 was another healthy outturn with an operating surplus of \$89.8 million (2017/18: \$107.4 million). The net deficit of CPCE for 2018/19 was \$10.2 million (2017/18: net surplus of \$7.4 million) after making a contribution of \$100 million (2017/18: \$100 million) to PolyU. Net assets of CPCE were valued at \$543.9 million as at 30 June 2019 (2017/18: \$554.1 million).

Same as 2017/18, the contribution of \$100 million to PolyU in 2018/19 was for general educational purposes in furtherance of the objects of both CPCE and PolyU, and with a view to repaying the two government loans borrowed by PolyU for construction of the two campuses used by CPCE and building up a capital reserve for the major renovation and maintenance of the two campuses. As of 30 June 2019, the outstanding loan amount was around \$464.3 million.

概述

專業及持續教育學院(以下簡稱「學院」)為香港 自資專上教育界別其中一所最具規模的機構。學院 是由香港理工大學(以下簡稱「理大」)成立的自資 學院,透過香港專上學院及專業及持續教育學院 有限公司兩間理大的附屬公司提供課程。專業及 持續教育學院有限公司由專業進修學院及專業及 持續教育學院轄下的行政部門所組成。香港專上 學院及專業進修學院主要開辦各項副學位及榮譽 學士學位銜接課程,並在2018/19學年為約一萬二千 名全日制學生提供優質專上教育機會。為配合社會 的不同需要,學院會繼續提供涵蓋不同範疇的持續 進修課程。

學院在2018/19年度的財務表現正是其另一 穩健成果,營運盈餘為8,980萬港元(2017/18: 1.074億港元)。扣除學院給予理大的1億港元供款 後(2017/18:1億港元),學院本年的淨虧損為 1.020萬港元(2017/18: 淨盈餘740萬港元)。截自 2019年6月30日止,學院的淨資產價值為5.439億 港元(2017/18:5.541億港元)。

與去年相同,學院於本年給予理大1億港元的 供款,是用以促進學院和理大的教學宗旨為目的。 以及用於償還兩筆由香港特別行政區政府借予理大 興建兩所提供給學院營運的校園之貸款,並為日後 兩所校園作大型翻新和維修預留儲備。於2019年 6月30日,學院尚欠貸款的金額約為4.643億港元。

Operating results and financial position

In 2018/19, the total income for CPCE (including HKCC and SPEED) was \$906.3 million (2017/18: \$918.4 million) and the total operating expenditure was \$816.5 million (2017/18: \$811 million), resulted in an operating surplus of \$89.8 million for the year (2017/18: \$107.4 million).

HKCC

Income of HKCC in 2018/19 was \$572.4 million (2017/18: \$546.9 million), representing a net increase of \$25.5 million. The increase was mainly due to the tuition fee adjustment for the 2018/19 intake. On the expenditure side, a total of \$501.1 million was incurred during the year (2017/18: \$471.7 million). The increase of \$29.4 million was mainly attributable to the deployment of additional resources for staffing, support for the whole-person development of students and enhancement of campus facilities.

SPEED

Income of SPEED in 2018/19 was \$333.9 million (2017/18: \$371.5 million), representing a net decrease of \$37.6 million. The decrease was a result of lower student enrolment for overseas academic award programmes and gradual phasing out of the franchising arrangement for PolyU award selffinancing top-up honours degree programmes, partially offset by tuition fee adjustment for PolyU-SPEED award programmes for the 2018/19 intake. On the expenditure side, SPEED recorded a total operating expenditure of \$315.4 million in 2018/19 (2017/18: \$339.3 million), representing a decrease of \$23.9 million. The decrease was mainly driven by the reduction of its operating cost in tandem with lower student enrolments.

營運結果及財務狀況

在2018/19年度,學院(包括香港專上學院及專業 進修學院) 的總營運收入為9.063億港元 (2017/18: 9.184億港元),而總營運開支為8.165億港元 (2017/18:8.11億港元)。年內學院錄得營運盈餘 8.980萬港元(2017/18:1.074億港元)。

香港專上學院

香港專上學院於2018/19年度的收入為5.724億港元 (2017/18:5.469億港元),較去年上升了2,550萬 港元。此增幅的主要原因是2018/19學年的學費調 整。在支出方面,年內的總營運開支為5.011億港元 (2017/18:4.717億港元)。此2,940萬港元的支出 增長主要是由於年內在人力資源、支持學生的全人 發展以及提升校園配套和設備方面,調配了更多 資源。

專業強修學院

專業進修學院於2018/19年度的收入為3.339億港元 (2017/18:3.715億港元),較去年減少了3,760萬 港元。此減幅的主要原因是報讀海外大學學銜課 程的學生人數下降以及逐步取消香港理工大學的 自資榮譽學士學位銜接課程的特許經營安排,而 部份減幅被2018/19學年理大專業進修學院學銜 課程的學費調整所抵銷。在支出方面,專業進修 學院於2018/19年度的總營運開支為3.154億港元 (2017/18:3.393億港元),共減少了2,390萬 港元。主要原因是因應學生人數下降而減低其營運 成本。

Financial outlook

Challenges remain over future student numbers for the self-financing tertiary education sector due to the gradual decline of the population of HKDSE school candidates and the increase in UGC-funded senior year degree places. The implementation of various supporting measures by the Government for designated self-financing institutions including the provision of an annual subsidy to eligible students pursuing full-time undergraduate programmes has put CPCE in a very challenging environment. While CPCE continues to stay focused to confront the challenges, it remains positive with the adoption of a two-pronged approach to maintain a steady stream of income and control of the overall cost base, underpinned by the quality and variety of its programmes; diversification of student sources; and the adoption of an efficient and resilient operation model for long term financial sustainability.

Scenario planning continues to play a key role in financial planning. The multi-year financial budget together with scenario analysis serves as a framework for achieving new levels of excellence and places CPCE on a sustainable path to accomplish its mission and realise its vision. The budget is prepared on a realistic basis with sensitivity assessment, encompassing the main assumptions as well as the potential risks arising from the external and governmental factors. The guiding principles for the budget include the effective management of its resources and accumulated surplus, and appropriate allocation for our students, staff and campus facilities to enhance the quality of education for the benefit of the students.

Besides the multi-year financial budget, CPCE has sound and credible plans in place to continue to deliver a viable and sustainable financial performance into the future. This includes setting aside various reserves for major renovation and maintenance of the two campuses, as a contingency for maintaining smooth operations for a few months in the event of unexpected financial adverse circumstances, and special requirements for other developmental initiatives.

財政展望

因香港中學文憑考試考牛人數將逐漸下降以及教資 會資助高年級學十學位的增加, 自資專上教育的 未來學生數目仍然面臨挑戰。政府對指定自資專上 教育院校實施各項支持措施,包括提供免入息審查 資助予合資格的全日制自資學士學位課程學生,已 使學院置於極具挑戰性的環境中。學院會繼續專注 及保持積極的態度去迎接這些挑戰,通過採用雙管 齊下的方法來保持穩定的收入和控制整體成本, 包括加強課程質素和其組合以及多樣化的學生 來源,並且採用高效和靈活的營運模式,以維持 長遠財務可持續性。

方案規劃繼續在財務規劃中發揮關鍵作用。多年度 財政預算連同方案分析成為實現卓越水平的框架, 使學院走上可持續發展的道路,以實現其使命和 願景。財政預算是以現實狀況為依據,並進行敏感 度評估,包括加入重要假設,以及外在和政府 因素驅動的潛在風險。財政預算的原則包括有效 管理學院的資源和累積盈餘; 並給予學生、教職員 和校園設施各方面適當的資源,以提高教學質素, 造福學生。

除了多年財務預算外,學院環制定了健全可靠的 計劃,有效維持學院的財務穩健和可持續性。這些 計劃包括為學院預留各項儲備作為兩所校園的大型 翻新和維修,以及在財政不利的情況下能夠維持 數個月的平穩運作和為日後其他發展項目作應急 之用。
