It gives me great pleasure to present to you this annual report which provides an overview of the developments and achievements of the College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) in 2021/22.

Founded in 2002, CPCE has developed into one of the largest self-financed tertiary institutions in Hong Kong, offering quality education through its two educational units, namely the Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) and the School of Professional Education and Executive Development (SPEED).

HKCC provides full-time associate degree and higher diploma programmes (i.e. sub-degree programmes) to graduates of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination, while SPEED offers part-time and full-time articulation honours degree programmes to sub-degree graduates and working adults. In addition, CPCE organises a wide array of continuing education courses for lifelong learners. These offerings provide learners with multiple education pathways to meet their learning needs at different stages of their studies and career.

Over the years, CPCE has been successful in nurturing students through an effective two-pronged approach: arming students with professional skills and knowledge via PolyU-accredited programmes, and enhancing their holistic development via a variety of extra-curricular activities supported by scholarships and other funding. These endeavours speak volumes about the College's commitment to nurturing students to become critical thinkers, effective communicators, innovative problem solvers and socially responsible global citizens.

I am gratified to learn that the 2021 cohort of HKCC and SPEED graduates, against all odds under the prolonged pandemic, managed to succeed with flying colours, with our HKCC graduates achieving an articulation rate of 90.7% and our SPEED graduates achieving an employment rate of 81.1%.

In the face of the very challenging environment in the local self-financed tertiary education sector complicated by multiple waves of the pandemic, CPCE has been able to ride on the firm foundation built over the past two decades and sail its way upstream to realise its vision and mission.

With the unwavering support and contributions of its staff, students, alumni and partners from different sectors, I am confident that CPCE will continue to make great strides in various strategic areas in the future.

我欣然向各位呈上這份年報，以總結 2021/22 年度香港理工大學（理大）轄下專業及持續教育學院（CPCE）的發展和成績。

2002 年成立的 CPCE，現已發展成為香港最具規模的自資院校之一，藉著轄下的香港專上學院（HKCC）和專業進修學院（SPEED），致力提供優質的專上教育。

HKCC 為香港中學文憑考試畢業生開辦全日制副學士學位及高級文憑課程（副學位課程），SPEED 則為副學位畢業生及在職人士開辦全日制及兼讀制榮譽學士學位銜接課程。此外，CPCE 亦為追求終身學習的人士提供不同的持續進修課程。這些課程為有意進修的人士提供多元的學習途徑，以滿足他們在不同學業及事業階段的學習需求。

多年來，CPCE 採取行之有效的雙管齊下方法：一方面透過理大審批的課程，向學生傳授專業技能和知識；另一方面則舉辦多姿多彩的課外活動，促進學生的全人發展，同時還提供相關的獎學金和資助。種種努力，無不反映學院矢志栽培學生成為敏於思辨、善於溝通、富於創見、精於解難、勇於承擔社會責任的世界公民。

2021 年 HKCC 畢業生的升學率（90.7%）和 SPEED 畢業生的就業率（81.1%）都令人欣慰。疫情曠日持久，他們卻能排除萬難取得良好成績，實在難得。

本地自資專上教育界的環境本已極具挑戰性，而接二連三的疫情爆發，無疑令形勢更加錯綜複雜。憑藉二十多年來建立的穩固基礎，CPCE 得以逆流而上，繼續實踐抱負、履行使命。

有賴教職員、學生、校友，以及各界合作夥伴的不吝付出和並肩同行，我深信，未來 CPCE 將在多個重要領域繼續取得長足的進步。

Message from the Dean

院長的話

The College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) and its teaching units – Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) and the School of Professional Education and Executive Development (SPEED) – continued to perform well despite the year was plagued by adversities. I have the pleasure to present in this Annual Report an overview of our achievements over the past year.

CPCE, a major provider of self-financed tertiary education in Hong Kong, offers quality educational opportunities to HKDSE and sub-degree graduates as well as working adults to upgrade their qualifications and help them fulfil their career aspirations. Although recent years have witnessed a decreasing trend in the number of HKDSE candidates, the full-time and part-time student population of CPCE still maintained at around 12,000 in 2021/22.

During the year, HKCC and SPEED offered respectively 36 full-time sub-degree programmes and 32 full-time and 9 part-time articulation honours degree programmes. In addition, SPEED also offered, through the Continuing Education Office, 46 continuing education courses encompassing various disciplines to practising professionals and lifelong learners.

It is gratifying to witness the articulation rate of HKCC graduates reaching 90.7% in 2021 – hitting a record high for the second consecutive year – with 2,922 graduates admitted to bachelor's degree programmes. As for SPEED, over 81% of full-time PolyU-SPEED award graduates secured employment within six months after graduation in 2021 – showing a year-over-year increase of seven percentage points amidst an increasingly volatile job market, while over 9% chose to pursue further study.

CPCE participated in the Student Barometer survey conducted by the independent research company “i-graduate” for the seventh consecutive year to benchmark its performance against over 100 educational institutions in 15 countries. In 2021, CPCE received an overall local student satisfaction rate of 85.8%, higher than the 83.6% in 2020. A satisfaction rate of 90% or above was obtained in many important teaching and learning elements, with the majority of them showing a significant improvement over ratings in 2020, including “Online Study Materials”, “Online Tutorials”, “The Quality of Lectures”, “Programme Content”, and “Academic’s English”.

We also established new ties with industry and professional bodies. During the year, CPCE signed a Memorandum of Understanding respectively with the Association of Hong Kong Nursing Staff, the Hong Kong Federation of Education Workers, Hong Kong Integrated Oncology Centre, Hong Kong Productivity Council, and Microsoft Hong Kong for exploring collaborative initiatives.

專業及持續教育學院 (CPCE) 及轄下教學單位—香港專上學院 (HKCC) 及專業進修學院 (SPEED) 在逆境之中仍能繼續保持佳績。我非常高興地向各位獻上這份年報，概述 CPCE 過去一年的成績。

CPCE 是香港規模最大的全日制自資專上院校之一，為香港中學文憑考試及副學位畢業生以及在職人士提供優質的教育機會，協助他們提升資歷及實踐事業抱負。縱然過去數年香港中學文憑考試考生人數持續下跌，2021/22 年度，CPCE 的全日制及兼讀制學生人數仍維持近 12,000 名。

年內，HKCC 開辦 36 項全日制副學位課程，SPEED 則提供 32 項全日制及 9 項兼讀制榮譽學士學位銜接課程。此外，SPEED 持續教育處亦為在職專業人士及終身學習人士提供 46 項持續進修課程，涵蓋多個學科範疇。


令人特別欣喜的是，HKCC 2021 年度畢業生的升學率高達 90.7%，連續第二年創下新高，共有 2,922 名畢業生升讀學士學位課程。至於 SPEED，縱然 2021 年就業市場非常波動，修畢全日制大專業進修學院學銜課程的畢業生當中，逾 81% 仍成功於畢業六個月內獲聘用，較上一年度上升七個百分點，另有逾 9% 選擇繼續進修。

CPCE 連續第七年參加獨立研究機構 i-graduate 進行的學生指標調查，與 15 個國家逾 100 間教學機構的表現作基準比較。2021 年，CPCE 的本地學生整體滿意度達 85.8%，高於 2020 年的 83.6%。在多項重要的教與學項目中，CPCE 取得的滿意度高達 90% 或以上，當中大部分指標均較 2020 年有明顯改善，包括「網上學習素材」、「網上導修」、「課堂質素」、「課程內容」及「講師英語水平」。

我們亦與業界及專業團體建立新的協作關係。年內，CPCE 與香港護士協會、香港教育工作者聯會、香港綜合腫瘤中心、香港生產力促進局及微軟香港，分別簽訂合作備忘錄，共同探討協作機會。

On the research front, CPCE, including HKCC and SPEED, obtained external funding totaling over HK\$21 million for 20 research projects in 2021/22, both hitting all-time highs. SPEED alone also achieved encouraging results in the Competitive Research Funding Schemes for the Local Self-financing Degree Sector 2021/22 under the Research Grants Council of the University Grants Committee – a record high number of 12 research projects being funded a total amount of around HK\$8.2 million. In addition, SPEED secured funding of over HK\$6.1 million – the highest amount among all the externally funded projects in 2021/22 – from the Self-financing Post-secondary Education Fund's Quality Enhancement Support Scheme for its project "Development of Virtual Reality (VR) Systems for Business and Tourism Education".

I am deeply indebted to the members of the College Council and College Advisory Committee for their contribution and guidance over the past year. I would also like to express my gratitude to our students, staff, alumni, and industry and academic partners for their support and effort – amidst adversities – making 2021/22 another thriving year for CPCE.

Organisation Development

CPCE established the following new offices in 2021/22 to further its strategic and long-term development.

CPCE Academic Registry

The CPCE Academic Registry (CAR) delivers a range of professional services related to academic programmes in CPCE. CAR comprises four sections: (1) Quality Assurance and Enhancement, (2) Admission and Registration, (3) Subject Registration and Class Timetabling, and (4) Examination, Graduation, Award and Certification.

CPCE Employability Services Office

The CPCE Employability Services Office (CESO) reaches out to employers for meaningful experiential learning experiences and gainful employment for CPCE students. CESO not only nurtures students with relevant attitudes, skills and knowledge to enhance their employability but also develops the entrepreneurship mindset and competence of those students who wish to strike out on their own.

CPCE Research Office

The CPCE Research Office provides holistic administrative support to enhance research endeavours in CPCE. It also supports the Associate Dean (Research) of CPCE and the CPCE Research Committee in devising and implementing strategies and policies that foster research development.

Campus and General Administration Office

The Campus and General Administration Office, in collaboration with the Campus Facilities Management Office, oversees campus amenities and the effective utilisation of space.

專業及持續教育學院教務處

專業及持續教育學院教務處為 CPCE 學術課程提供一系列相關的專業服務。教務處職責涵蓋四大範疇：（一）質素保證及提升、（二）入學及註冊、（三）科目註冊及課堂時間表，以及（四）考試、畢業、學銜和資歷認證。

專業及持續教育學院就業服務處

CPCE 就業服務處 (CESO) 主動聯繫僱主，為 CPCE 學生提供富有意義的體驗式學習經歷和待遇良好的工作。CESO 不僅致力培養學生就業相關的態度、技能和知識，以提高他們的就業能力，還協助有志創業的學生鍛鍊創業思維和能力。

專業及持續教育學院研究事務處

CPCE 研究事務處提供全面的行政支援，以加強 CPCE 的研究工作。此外，該處亦協助 CPCE 副院長（研究）和 CPCE 研究委員會制定和推行促進研究發展的策略和政策。

校園及行政事務處

校園及行政事務處與校園設施管理辦事處合作，負責管理校園設施及善用空間。

Overview of CPCE, HKCC, SPEED and Four Academic Divisions

專業及持續教育學院、香港專上學院、專業進修學院和四個學部概覽

Founded in 2002 as a self-financing college of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU), the College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) oversees the operations and development of its two educational units – Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) and School of Professional Education and Executive Development (SPEED) as well as four academic divisions – Business and Hospitality Management, Languages and Communication, Science, Engineering and Health Studies, and Social Sciences, Humanities and Design. The four divisions focus their efforts on scholarly activities of their respective academic disciplines, not least that of providing teaching and learning support for HKCC and SPEED.

With a flexible “2+2” articulation pathway provided by CPCE, HKCC graduates, after completing a 2-year Associate Degree (AD) or Higher Diploma (HD) programme, may articulate to SPEED’s 2-year articulation honours degree programmes leading to PolyU-SPEED awards.

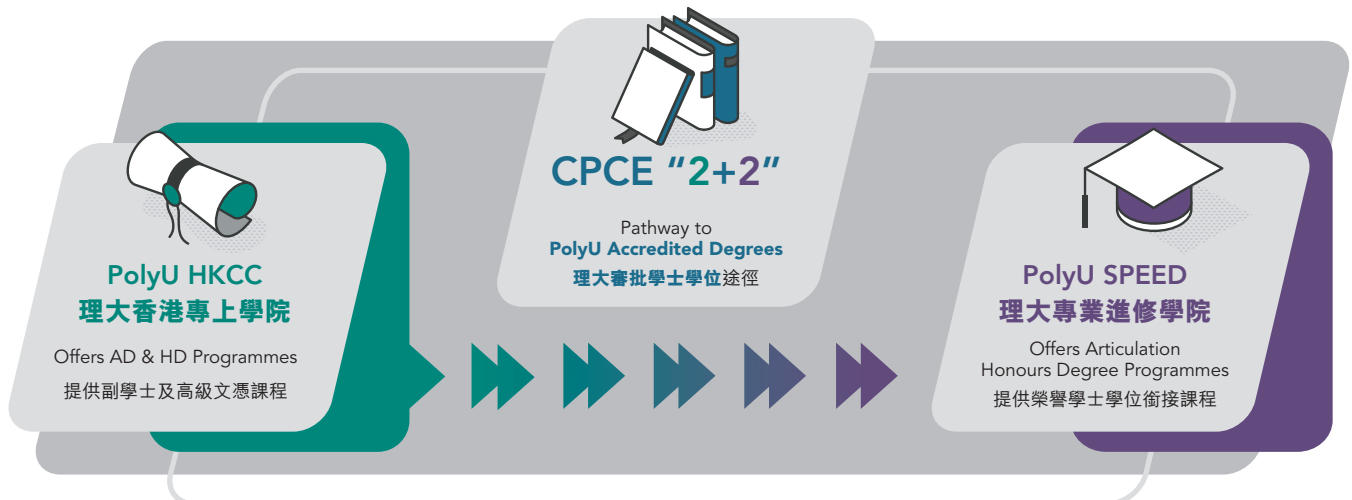
專業及持續教育學院 (CPCE) 成立於 2002 年，是隸屬於香港理工大學 (理大) 的自資學院，專責統籌和管理轄下兩個教學單位—香港專上學院 (HKCC) 和專業進修學院 (SPEED)，以及四個學部—工商及款待業管理學部；語文及傳意學部；科技、工程及健康學部；社會科學、人文及設計學部。四個學部專注所屬學科範疇的學術工作，並致力為 HKCC 及 SPEED 提供教學支援。

CPCE 提供靈活的「2+2」升學途徑，HKCC 學生完成兩年制副學士或高級文憑課程後，可升讀 SPEED 兩年制榮譽學士學位銜接課程，取得理大專業進修學院學銜。

In 2021/22, HKCC offered 36 full-time AD and HD programmes, spanning the domains of arts, science, social sciences, business and the specialised areas of design and health studies. SPEED offered 32 full-time and 9 part-time articulation honours degree programmes leading to PolyU-SPEED awards in 10 disciplines, namely Accountancy; Building, Surveying and Property Management; Business; Design; Engineering; Health, Information Technology and Data Science; Hospitality and Tourism Management; Language and Communication; Marketing; Social Sciences and Humanities.

During the year, HKCC launched Associate in Applied Social Sciences (Counselling for Social Services) and Associate in Design (Moving Image and Interaction Design); SPEED introduced, in full-time and part-time modes of study, BA (Hons) in Business (Innovation and Design Management) and BSc (Hons) in Property and Asset Management.

In addition, SPEED offered continuing education programmes/courses, corporate training and consultancy services to enable working adults to add value to their careers. SPEED also continued to provide law courses and business programmes in collaboration with the University of London, the United Kingdom and Northumbria University's Newcastle Business School, the United Kingdom respectively.

於 2021/22 學年，HKCC 開辦 36 項全日制副學士及高級文憑課程，涵蓋文、理、社、商範疇，也有設計及健康學專科。SPEED 則開辦 32 項全日制及 9 項兼讀制理大專業進修學院學銜的榮譽學士學位銜接課程，涵蓋十大學科範疇：會計；建築、測量及物業管理；商業；設計；工程；健康學、資訊科技及數據科學；款待業及旅遊業管理；語文及傳意；市場營銷；社會科學及人文學。

年內，HKCC 推出應用社會科學副學士（社會服務輔導）和設計學副學士（流動影像與互動設計）；SPEED 推出全日制及兼讀制商業（榮譽）文學士（創新及設計管理）和物業及資產管理學（榮譽）理學士。

此外，SPEED 提供持續進修課程、企業培訓及顧問服務，協助在職人士為事業增值。SPEED 亦繼續與英國倫敦大學及英國諾桑比亞大學紐卡素商學院合作，分別開辦法律課程及商業課程。

Continuing Education Courses 持續進修課程

Despite COVID-19 and various challenges in 2021/22, the Continuing Education Office (CEO) of SPEED continued to flourish in the provision of professional education and corporate training. This could be attributed to the concerted efforts of a dedicated CEO team and the support from the four Academic Divisions of CPCE.

The CEO made good progress in key priority areas including Business Management, Digital Marketing, E-Commerce, Health Services, Professional Communication, and Property Management. By launching 46 continuing education courses and programmes leading to recognised qualifications at Levels 4 to 6 under the Qualifications Framework (QF) as well as corporate training courses, the CEO enrolled more than 1,500 part-time students for its courses in 2021/22.

In addition to Primary Healthcare programmes, the CEO collaborated with the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences of PolyU to offer two advanced specialty courses: the Professional Certificate in Advanced Specialty Training in Cardiopulmonary Physiotherapy and the Professional Certificate in Advanced Specialty Training in Orthopaedic Services for Occupational Therapists. Pitched at QF Level 6, these two courses targeted registered occupational therapists and registered physiotherapists of the Hospital Authority.

On the heels of the successful Certificate in Property Management for Provisional Property Management Practitioner (Tiers 1&2) License, the CEO further explored opportunities in providing practitioners with Continuing Professional Development and specified academic qualifications in property management. Besides, the Certificate in Building Quality Inspection programme was newly approved in 2021/22.

The CEO continued to collaborate with AXA to conduct a series of training programmes in healthcare management for the latter's wealth management and insurance professionals. The two parties also developed new training programmes in retirement planning. Besides, CEO established a new partnership with the Hong Kong Integrated Oncology Centre to offer professional training in health services management and communication skills to the latter's staff.

With strong support from the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, experts and notable speakers from various sectors, the first ever QF-recognised Advanced Certificate in Emergency and Disaster Management in Hong Kong offered by the CEO was hailed as a resounding success. The second intake of this course was launched in the second quarter of 2022.

儘管遇上新冠疫情及種種挑戰，SPEED 持續教育處於 2021/22 年度仍能在專業教育和企業培訓領域蓬勃發展，這實在有賴專業的團隊和 CPCE 四個學部的支持。

持續教育處在商業管理、數碼營銷、電子商務、醫療保健、專業傳意及物業管理等關鍵專業範疇取得良好進展，推出 46 個持續進修課程、資歷架構第 4 至 6 級的認可學術課程，以及企業培訓課程。2021/22 年度修讀相關課程的兼讀制學生逾 1,500 名。

除基層醫療保健課程外，持續教育處繼續與理大康復治療科學系合作，為醫院管理局註冊職業治療師及註冊物理治療師提供兩項資歷架構第 6 級的高階專職培訓課程，分別為心肺康復物理治療高階專職培訓專業證書和職業治療師骨科服務高階專職培訓專業證書。

隨著物業管理業監管局指明課程（第 1 級及第 2 級）取得成功，持續教育處計劃提供持續專業發展和指定學歷的物業管理課程予從業者。此外，新課程樓宇質量檢測證書已於 2021/22 年度獲批核。

持續教育處亦繼續與 AXA 安盛合作，為該公司的理財顧問和保險專業人員提供一系列醫療保健管理培訓課程；雙方亦正在籌辦有關退休策劃的新培訓課程。此外，持續教育處亦與香港綜合腫瘤中心展開合作，為後者的員工提供有關醫務行政管理與溝通技巧的專業培訓。

另外，在香港賽馬會慈善信託基金及不同領域的專家和知名講者的大力支持下，持續教育處成功推出香港首個獲資歷架構認可的危急及災難管理高等證書課程，並廣獲好評。第二屆課程亦於 2022 年第二季舉辦。

In 2021/22, the CEO continued to develop strategic alliances with more professional bodies and organisations including Hong Yip People Development Academy, the Association of Hong Kong Nursing Staff, and the Education Training and Exchange Centre of the Hong Kong Federation of Education Workers.

CEO also secured a new round of funding from the Education Bureau for continuing to organise in 2023 the Applied Learning Chinese Course (ApL) for non-Chinese speaking high school students, with academic support from the Division of Languages and Communication.

The Centre for Professional and Business English (CPBE) also operates under the SPEED umbrella.

CPBE's core business is delivering workshops on high impact professional writing to working adults who are otherwise already competent English users. By improving the clarity of their professional documents, organisations can increase productivity. In addition to offering training to civil servants through key government training departments, the CPBE also completed several training projects for the Hong Kong Monetary Authority and the Housing Authority in the public sector, and for the German supermarket chain ALDI and the NASDAQ-listed MKS Instruments in the private sector.

Beyond training, the CPBE also provided a recruitment screening service for five government departments, including the Treasury, the Immigration Department, and the Environmental Protection Department. It also provided English editing and proofreading services for CPCE and PolyU academic staff.

Looking ahead, the CEO will continue to expand its portfolio, sustain its excellence and work closely with its strategic partners to better serve the community through the provision of more continuing education and professional development courses in 2022/23.

2021/22 年度，持續教育處與更多專業團體及機構建立策略夥伴關係，包括康業人才發展學院、香港護士協會，以及香港教育工作者聯會教育培訓交流中心。

持續教育處已獲教育局新一筆撥款，於 2023 年繼續為非華語高中學生開辦應用學習中文課程，並由語文及傳意學部提供學術支援。

專業及商業英語中心同樣隸屬於 SPEED。

專業及商業英語中心的核心工作是為已具備一定英語水平的在職人士提供具高效能的專業英語寫作培訓。通過改善員工的寫作能力，機構的生產力亦會得以提升。除了與政府主要培訓部門緊密合作，為公務員提供培訓，專業及商業英語中心還為香港金融管理局和香港房屋委員會等公營機構，以及德國連鎖超級市場 ALDI 和納斯達克上市公司萬機儀器等私營機構完成了多個培訓項目。

除培訓外，專業及商業英語中心還為五個政府部門，包括庫務署、入境事務處和環境保護署，提供招聘篩選測試服務。該中心也為 CPCE 和理大學術人員提供英文編輯和校對服務。

展望 2022/23 年度，持續教育處將繼續發展業務，追求卓越，與策略夥伴緊密合作，提供更多持續教育及專業發展課程，服務社會。



Service-Learning 服務學習

Service-Learning (SL) is an experiential learning approach that integrates academic study with community service and self-reflection to enrich students' learning experiences and to contribute to the community. Since the introduction of the first SL subject in 2016/17, students of full-time articulation honours degree programmes leading to PolyU-SPEED awards can either take a 3-credit SL subject or a free elective as a part of the graduation requirement.

In 2021/22, a total of 86 students enrolled on three SL subjects, namely "Practices in Health Promotion" and "Teaching Primary School Students English as a Service-Learning Experience", offered by SPEED in collaboration with Sik Sik Yuen and New Home Association respectively, as well as "Using Human-Centered Design to Work with the Elderly: A Memoir Project".

In view of the pandemic, some subjects adopted a non-traditional SL approach where students organised activities via video conferencing and made online info videos to interact with the community and service recipients. Not only could students put knowledge into practice, they could also enhance their problem-solving skills and adaptiveness.

服務學習是一項體驗式學習法，把社會服務與自我反思融入學習之中，藉此豐富學生的學習經歷，同時造福社區。自 2016/17 學年推出首個服務學習科目後，PolyU-SPEED 學銜全日制榮譽學士學位銜接課程的學生，可以選擇修讀 3 個學分的服務學習科目或其他選修科，代替服務學習科目，從而符合畢業條件之中選修科的要求。

於 2021/22 學年，共有 86 位學生修讀三個服務學習科目，分別為 SPEED 與舊色園合作的 Practices in Health Promotion，以及與新家園協會合作的 Teaching Primary School Students English as a Service-Learning Experience 和 Using Human-Centered Design to Work with the Elderly: A Memoir Project。

因應疫情，部分科目採用了非傳統的服務學習模式，學生以視像形式籌辦不同類型的活動和製作網上資訊影片，藉此與社會及服務對象接觸和交流。實踐所學之餘，學生亦可強化解決問題和應變能力。

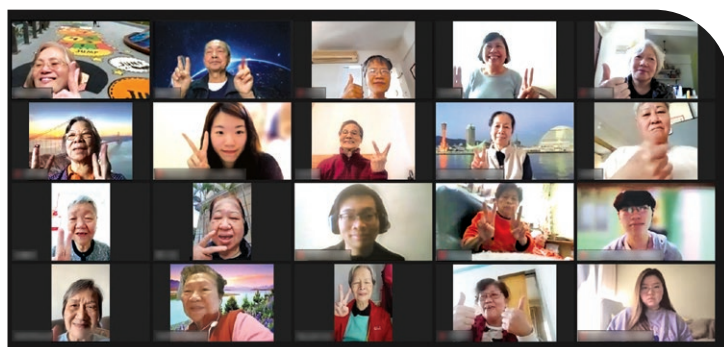

Pedagogical Innovation Fund

創新教學基金

Launched by the College Learning and Teaching Committee (CLTC) of CPCE in 2019/20, the Pedagogical Innovation Fund (PIF) encourages academic staff to test and pilot innovative ideas.

In 2021/22, staff were invited to submit proposals on pedagogical innovations which would bring about an intentional, measurable and sustainable improvement in student learning approaches, attitudes and/or behaviours.

Based on four criteria, namely impact on teaching and learning, novelty, feasibility and adaptability/transferability, the CLTC carried out a rigorous selection exercise of the proposals and approved the following:

- Embedding Virtual Learning Stimulations to Conventional Classroom Teaching
- The Efficacy of Recorded Video Lessons (RVL) on Facilitating Students' Learning: Mechanisms and Interventions

於 2021/22 年度，教員獲邀提交創新教學項目計劃書，為學生的學習方式、態度和/或行為帶來有目的、可衡量和可持續的改進。

學院教學委員會以四大準則，即對教與學的影響、創新性、可行性，以及適應性/可轉移性，嚴格篩選計劃書，並批核了以下項目：

- 將虛擬學習刺激功能融入傳統課堂教學
- 以預先錄影的課堂促進學生的學習成效：運作和介入方法



Student Barometer 2021

2021 年學生指標調查

CPCE participated in the Student Barometer (SB) exercise for the seventh consecutive year, and its performance was on par with the global and Asian benchmarks in various aspects of students' experience.

The SB exercise, conducted by the independent research company "i-graduate", is a global survey¹ of students' experience in the areas of arrival, learning, living, support, and the institutions' response to COVID-19. In 2021, CPCE received an overall local student satisfaction rate² of 85.8%, higher than last year's 83.6% and comparable with this year's global and Asian benchmarks.

Among the local students of the participating institutions, the survey revealed that:

- In learning elements, CPCE attained a high average student satisfaction rate³ of 88%, which was on par with the global benchmark of 88.1% and the Asian benchmark of 90.1%.
- Of the 36 individual learning elements, CPCE outperformed both the global and Asian benchmarks in 9 of them; "Online Lectures" attained the highest rate of 94.6%, much higher than the global benchmark of 87% and the Asian benchmark of 90.5%. Besides, CPCE achieved a satisfaction rate of 90% or above in 17 elements, with the majority of them showing a significant improvement over last year's ratings, including "Online Study Materials", "Online Tutorials", "The Quality of Lectures", "Programme Content", and "Academic's English".
- With respect to "Careers Advisory Service" under the area of support, CPCE continued to receive a very high student satisfaction rate of 96.7%, better than both the global benchmark of 91.3% and the Asian benchmark of 94.6%. Moreover, 9 out of the 11 elements of support services recorded a rate above 90%.

CPCE 連續第七年參與學生指標調查，在多個有關學生學習體驗的項目中，CPCE 的表現與國際及亞洲基準相若。

學生指標調查由獨立研究機構 i-graduate 統籌和進行，旨在探討全球學生¹於迎新安排、學習、校園生活、學院支援服務及學院應對新冠疫情的體驗。於2021年，CPCE 的本地學生整體滿意度²達 85.8%，高於去年的 83.6%，並與本年度的國際基準和亞洲基準相若。

從參與院校本地生的調查意見反映：

- 學生對 CPCE 教學相關指標的平均滿意度³達 88%，與國際基準的 88.1% 及亞洲基準的 90.1% 相若。
- 在 36 項教學相關指標中，CPCE 在其中 9 項的表現優於國際及亞洲基準。其中，「網上課堂」獲得最高的滿意度：94.6%，顯著高於國際基準的 87% 及亞洲基準的 90.5%。另外，CPCE 在其中 17 項的學生滿意度高達 90% 或以上，當中大部分指標均較去年有明顯改善，包括「網上學習素材」、「網上導修」、「課堂質素」、「課程內容」及「講師英語水平」。
- 在學院支援服務方面，學生對學院提供的就業諮詢服務的滿意度高達 96.7%，優於國際基準的 91.3% 及亞洲基準的 94.6%。此外，在 11 個支援服務項目之中，9 項的滿意度逾 90%。

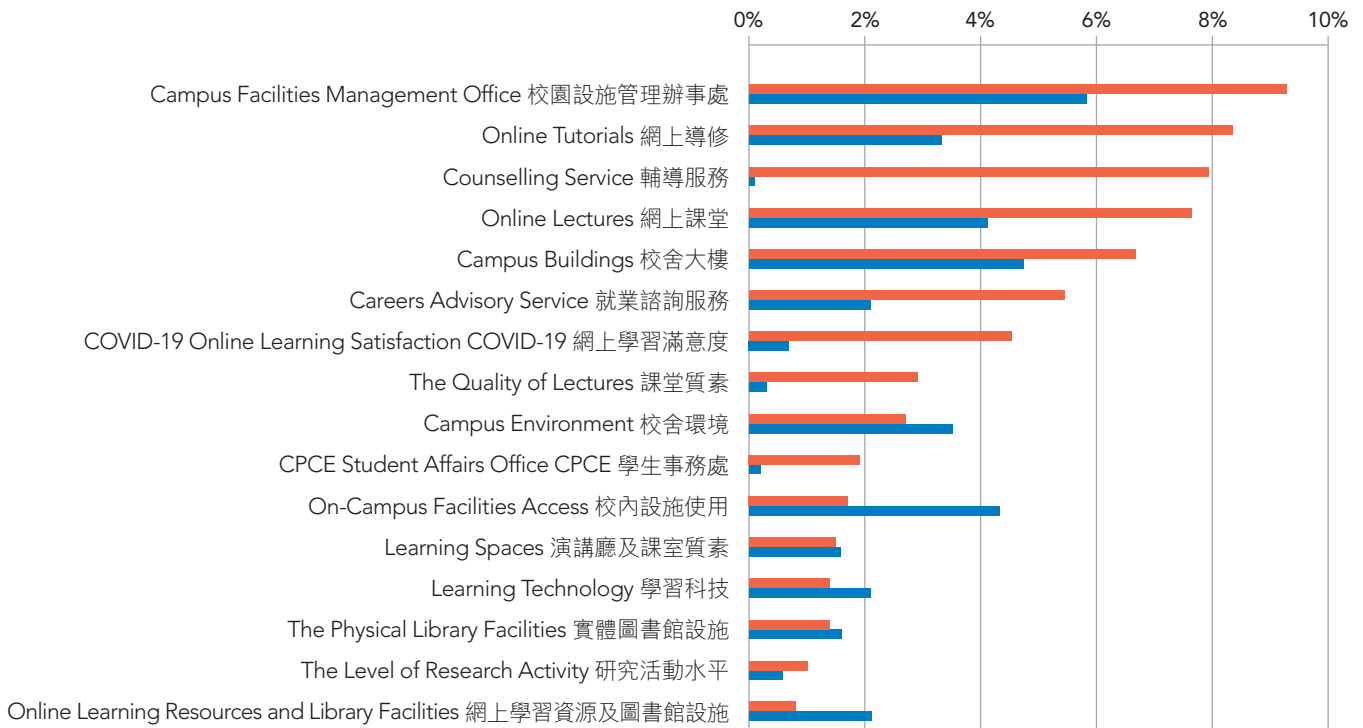

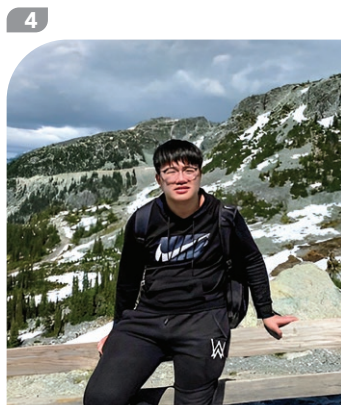

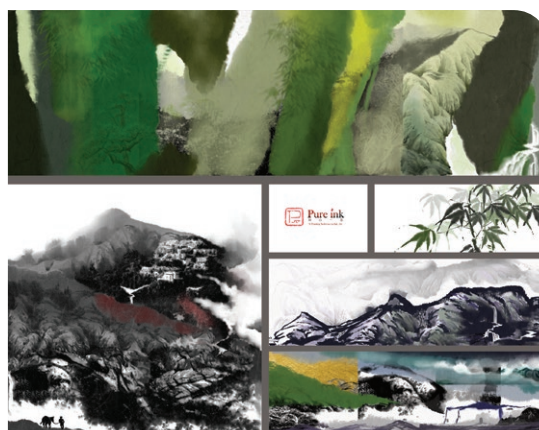

Every year, the CPCE Student Affairs Office (CSAO) works closely with HKCC and SPEED to organise a wide array of student development activities to facilitate the holistic development of students.

The services and activities offered by the CSAO encompass three main areas: Personal Growth, Counselling Services, and Further Studies and Career Development.

In 2021/22, the CSAO, HKCC and SPEED altogether organised over 530 student development activities with more than 34,100 places.

Business Excellence Contest 2021/22 卓越商業大賽 2021/22

The Final of the Business Excellence Contest 2021/22 was held on 22 April 2022. For the first time, the contest was divided into the Secondary Group (Secondary 4 to 6 students) and the Post-secondary Group (sub-degree and self-financing undergraduate students), attracting over 100 student teams to compete for the championship.

With the theme of “Green Innovation Campaign”, the contest required the participating teams to each select a real corporation in Hong Kong for conducting a business and market analysis, formulating a green innovation campaign, developing a new product (package)/service, and then mapping out a promotion strategy.

All the shortlisted teams for the Final presented their proposals via PowerPoint with voice-overs. In the Post-secondary Group, Green SF Express, a team from SPEED, won the Gold Award; Tempo’s Green Tissue from HKCC received the Silver Award while Driving Course with VR Training from the Hang Seng University of Hong Kong, the Bronze Award.

The 17th Young Entrepreneur Scheme (YES) 第 17 屆青年企業家計劃

The final round of the 17th Young Entrepreneur Scheme (YES) was conducted online on 5 March 2022. With the continued sponsorship from three professional bodies, namely the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) Hong Kong, the Association of International Accountants (AIA) Hong Kong Branch, and the Hong Kong Institute of Accredited Accounting Technicians (HKIAAT), the competition attracted a total of 44 student teams from HKCC and SPEED.

Guest adjudicators including partners and senior executives from accounting firms and corporates were very impressed by the innovative business ideas and outstanding performance of the competing student teams. They also shared with these students their suggestions on how to stand out from the crowd when seeking investors.

ParkX, a team formed by HKCC and SPEED students, garnered the Champion award; Se Détendre and BowlEat, both from HKCC, won the First Runner-up award and the Second Runner-up award respectively.

Scholarships, Student Support Funds and Financial Assistance 獎學金、學生培育基金及資助

In 2021/22, CPCE (including CSAO, HKCC and SPEED) spent HK\$28.5 million on student development activities, scholarships and support funds. A total of 1,447 scholarship places and support fund places were offered to students and graduates of HKCC and SPEED.

HKCC offered students and graduates 18 scholarships and support funds under three categories, namely Recognising Outstanding Performances, Supporting Learning and All-round Development, and Encouraging Internationalisation and Cultural Exchange.

SPEED granted eight scholarships and awards to students and graduates with outstanding academic performance and all-round achievements.

於 2021/22 學年，CPCE（包括 CSAO、HKCC 及 SPEED）用於學生發展活動、獎學金及贊助金的款項合計為港幣 2,850 萬元，為 HKCC 及 SPEED 學生和畢業生提供了 1,447 個獎學金及培育基金名額。

A total of 376 HKCC and 45 SPEED outstanding students and graduates earned the Outstanding Performance Scholarship, Endeavour Scholarship, Talent Development Scholarship, Best Progress Award and Reaching Out Award – totaling over HK\$8.54 million – in the 2021/22 HKSAR Government SPSS.

The CPCE Student Hostel, a five-storey building, offers a co-living environment to facilitate students' holistic development and enrich their college life. It is conveniently located in Mong Kok and within 10 minutes' walk from the PolyU West Kowloon Campus.

The hostel offers 44 bed spaces with facilities including common space, Wi-Fi, and cleaning services.

In view of the pandemic, the occupancy rate in 2021/22 was kept at around 70% so as to reduce density, thus minimising the risk of cross infection among residents. Besides, all residents must be fully vaccinated.

With the upsurge of COVID-19 cases in February 2022, residents were advised to move out of the hostel temporarily to reduce face-to-face contact while those with genuine accommodation needs could stay. Rapid test kits were provided to residents and a hostel tutor was stationed in the hostel to provide support.

2022 年 2 月新冠個案急升期間，學院勸喻宿生暫時遷出，以減少面對面接觸，而有實際居住需要的宿生則可留下，並獲派發快速測試包，亦有宿舍導師駐守，提供協助。

Articulation and Employment Prospects

In 2021/22, graduates of HKCC achieved a record high articulation rate while those of SPEED performed well in seeking employment.

於 2021/22 年度，HKCC 畢業生的升學率創下歷年新高，而 SPEED 畢業生的就業表現也很理想。

HKCC Articulation Rate Hits 90.7%

According to the HKCC Graduate Survey 2021, a total of 2,922 graduates articulated to bachelor's degree programmes, representing a record high articulation rate of 90.7%. Among those:

- 62.9% (1,837) were admitted to government-funded bachelor's degree programmes.
- 49% (1,431) were admitted to UGC senior year places.
- 77% (2,250) were admitted to degree programmes (including self-financing ones) leading to awards of the eight UGC-funded universities.

Regarding articulation opportunities provided by PolyU, among the 2,922 graduates who articulated into bachelor's degree programmes, 28.4% were admitted to PolyU, while 12.9% enrolled on self-financing PolyU-SPEED award articulation honours degree programmes.

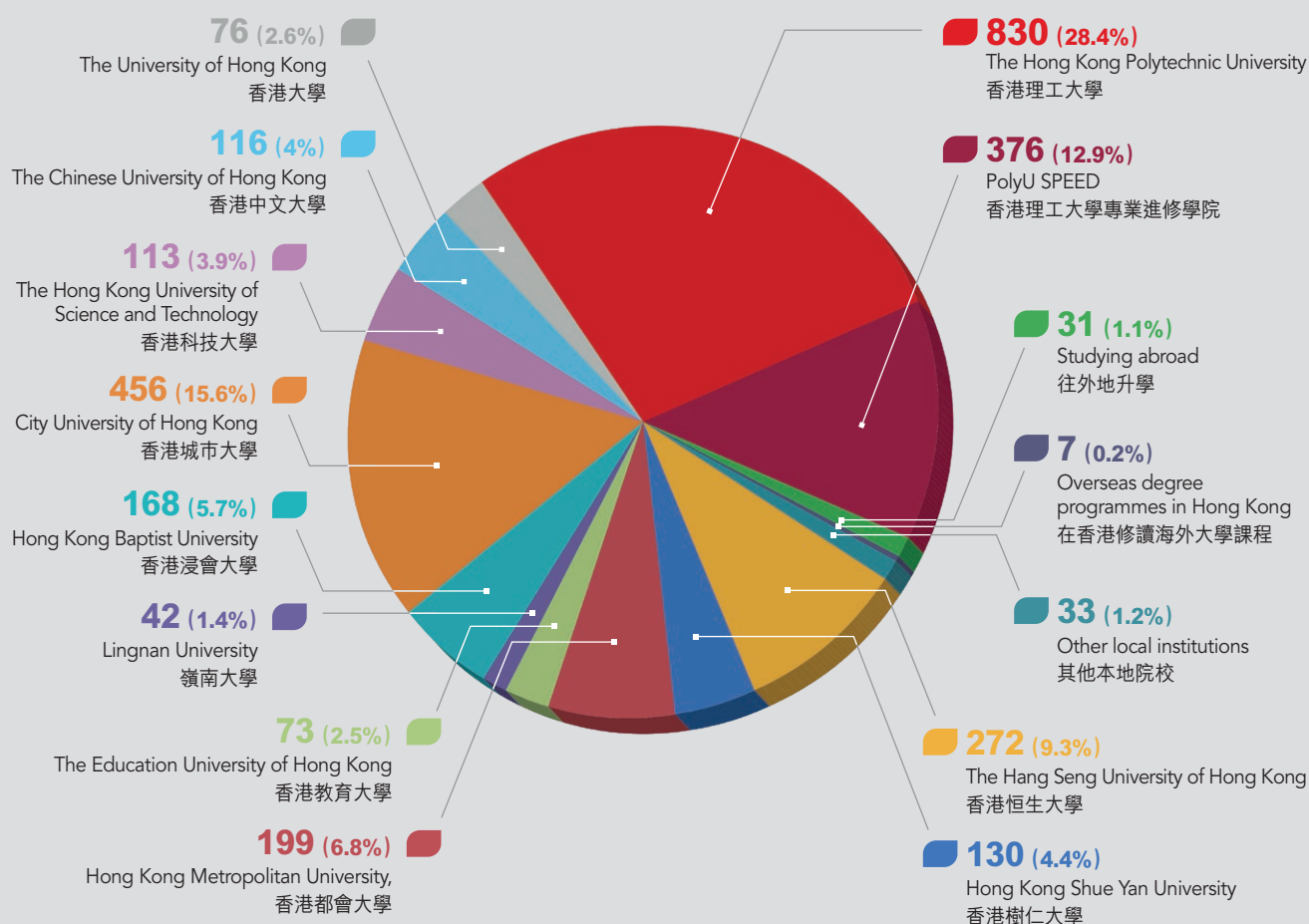

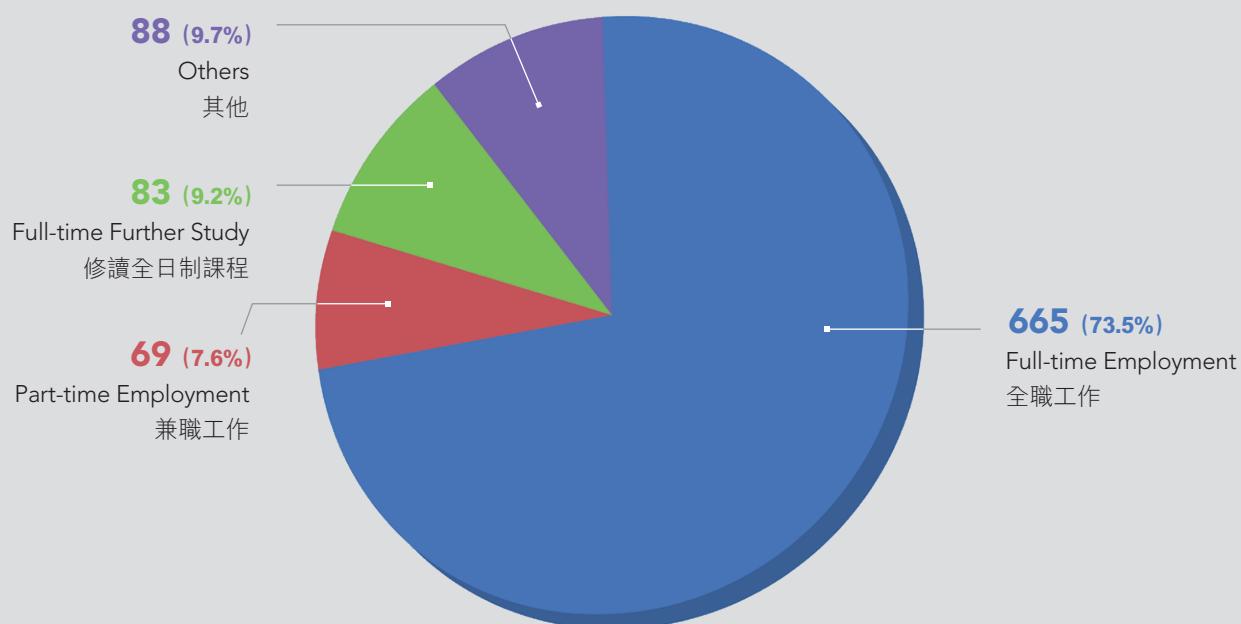

According to the SPEED Graduate Employment Survey 2021, a total of 734 graduates of full-time PolyU-SPEED award programmes secured employment within six months after graduation, representing an employment rate of 81.1%. In addition, 9.2% of the respondents pursued further study on a full-time basis.

Externally-funded Projects 獲校外資助的項目

CPCE, including HKCC and SPEED, obtained in 2021/22 external funding totaling over HK\$21 million for 20 research projects, both numbers hitting record highs.

Research Grants Council (RGC)'s Competitive Research Funding Schemes for the Local Self-financing Degree Sector

RGC Inter-Institutional Development Scheme (IIDS)

The project *Research Directions and Applications of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Smart Tourism in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macau Greater Bay Area (GBA)* received funding of over HK\$370,000.

A collaboration of our research team with experts in the tourism industry and renowned researchers from mainland China (Southwestern University of Finance and Economics), Macau (Macao Institute for Tourism Studies and City University of Macau) and Hong Kong (The Education University of Hong Kong), this project enabled local and overseas scholars, teachers, government officers and industry practitioners in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macau Greater Bay Area to exchange ideas on the latest developments and technologies applied in smart tourism through one conference and three seminars.

RGC Faculty Development Scheme (FDS)

Co-led by Dr Hau-ling Chan, Lecturer, and Dr Helen Wong, Division Head, both from the Division of Business and Hospitality Management, the research project *Circular Supply Chain Management with Bayesian Information Updating, Government Policies and Strategic Alliance for Sustainability Commitment* received funding of more than HK\$660,000.

The purpose of this project was to advance the knowledge of circular supply chain management based on quantitative analysis. The findings would provide business firms with managerial insights into inventory ordering decisions under circular supply chain management and generate insights for the development of government policy in promoting sustainable practices to create a better living environment.

研資局教員發展計劃

由工商及款待業管理學部講師陳巧玲博士和學部主任黃舜敏博士共同領導的研究項目「**貝葉斯信息更新、政府政策與可持續發展聯盟的循環供應鏈管理**」，獲撥款逾港幣 66 萬元。

此項目以定量分析為基礎，旨在增進循環供應鏈管理的知識。研究結果將提供新見解，有助商業公司管理庫存訂購決策，亦有助政府制訂政策去推廣可持續發展的實踐，從而改善生活環境。

The project *Investigating the Motivators and Obstacles of Mobile Health Apps Adoption and Continuance by Elderly: A Longitudinal Study Using Extended Expectation-Confirmation Theory* obtained funding of over HK\$460,000.

This was the first project which used the longitudinal method to investigate the changes in elderly users' perceptions of using mobile healthcare applications (mHealth apps) in Hong Kong, with the aim of finding more effective ways to raise the elderly's awareness of health technology and thus alleviate the burden on the healthcare system.

項目「**調查影響老年人對流動健康應用程式的採用和延續性的動機和障礙：使用擴展期望確認理論的縱向研究**」，獲撥款逾港幣 46 萬元。

這個研究項目使用縱向方法，探討長者在長期使用流動健康應用程式之後，在認知上所經歷的變化，是本港首個同類型的項目。此項目旨在尋找更有效的方法去提高長者使用健康科技的意識，從而減輕醫療系統的負擔。

The project *Destination Competitiveness in a Post-COVID-19 World* received funding of over HK\$630,000 to study destination competitiveness based on crisis management and preparedness.

The findings would advise the tourism industry and various stakeholders on revitalising their destinations and also suggest the target markets of post-COVID-19 tourism.

This project was led by Dr Bill Xu, Senior Lecturer of the Division of Business and Hospitality Management (BHM), with Dr Edmund Wut, Senior Lecturer, and Dr Pamela Ho, Lecturer of the BHM serving as Co-Investigators.

研究結果有望幫助旅遊業和各持份者就如何振興目的地提供意見，亦會建議哪些地點應該是後疫情時代旅遊業的目標市場。

此項目由工商及款待業管理學部高級講師徐景博士領導，而學部的高級講師屈大明博士和講師何秀盈博士則擔任共同研究員。

Led by Dr Simon Yuen, Senior Lecturer of the Division of Business and Hospitality Management, the project *Creating Zero Medicine Wastage and Sustainable Healthcare Supply Chain: A Closer Cooperation between Private Clinics and Pharmaceutical Companies* was granted funding of over HK\$480,000.

This project aimed to identify the factors determining the cooperation among private clinics, pharmaceutical companies and logistics service providers in Hong Kong; it would also develop a new framework for buyer-supplier cooperation and adaptation.

此項目旨在找出哪些因素會影響香港的私營診所、製藥公司和物流服務供應商三者之間的合作，並發展新框架，促進買家與供應商之間的合作和適應。

The project *Development of a Cloud-Based System to Facilitate End-User-Oriented Design (EOD) for Effective Sustainability Practices Implementation in High-Rise Residential Buildings* received funding of nearly HK\$630,000.

This project intended to solicit views from different project stakeholders on residential design, sustainability, and maintenance issues via a cloud-based EOD platform which could foster real-time communication between professionals and end-users, with the aim of promoting sustainability and minimising abortive design works in high-rise residential buildings in Hong Kong.

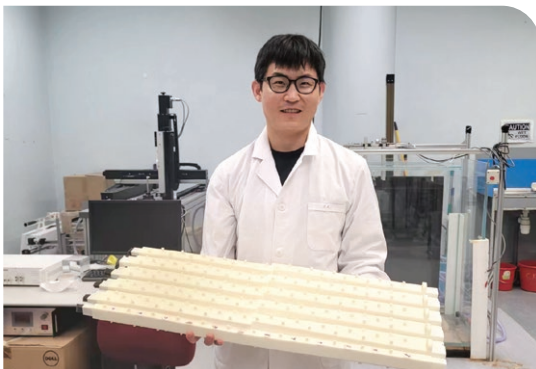

The project *Design and Implementation of Acoustic-controlled Ventilation Louvre with Metamaterial Technology* secured funding of about HK\$880,000.

Led by Dr Junot Liang, Lecturer of the Division of Science, Engineering and Health Studies, this project aimed to develop acoustic louvres with high ventilation and noise insulation performance by employing acoustic metamaterial technology. Such enhancement could guide policymakers to further promote green buildings and eco-friendly policies.

「基於超材料技術的通風隔音裝置的設計與實現」項目獲撥款約港幣 88 萬元。

此項目由科技、工程及健康學部講師梁善軍博士領導，旨在運用超材料技術，製造出高度通風、高度隔音的聲學百葉窗，並可望引導政策制定者加強推動綠色建築和環保政策。

The project *Modelling of Quantitative Dynamic Fit of Respirators for Healthcare Workers* received funding of about HK\$1 million.

This project aimed to develop quantitative models for evaluating the numerical “fit factors” of N95 respirators in dynamic states through the combination of 3D face modelling and experimental fit tests.

The outcomes could be used to improve the existing design of respirator sizes and shapes in order to enhance N95 respirators’ fit performance in dynamic facial/body conditions.

The project *Development of a Multi-agent Behaviour Model and Optimization of Charging Station Map for Implementation of Electric Taxis in Hong Kong - a Pilot Study* received funding of over HK\$680,000.

This project aimed to investigate the feasible penetration and promotion of electric vehicles (EV) for taxi services in Hong Kong, develop a multi-agent behaviour model to optimise the potential locations of EV charging stations for taxis in a pre-selected pilot district, and provide relevant suggestions on sustainable development for policymakers.

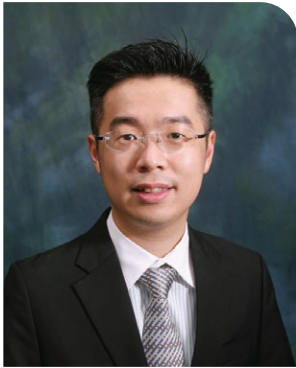


Dr Andrew Wu, Lecturer of the Division of Science, Engineering and Health Studies and Principal Investigator, expects to conduct a groundbreaking study on enhancing the competitiveness of the taxi industry.

科技、工程及健康學部講師及首席研究員武陽博士期望進行開創性研究，以提升的士行業的競爭力。

The project *Vertical Dispersion Model of Road Traffic-emitted Particulate Matters and Noise* was granted funding of about HK\$1 million.

This project would identify the existence of observable nucleation events of ultrafine particles through time-series and diurnal analyses. In addition, traffic noise measurements at locations would be collected to investigate the noise reduction contribution of different types of road pavement. The data gathered would be analysed to explore the relationship between emitted particulate matters and noise so that a prediction model on their vertical dispersion rate and vertical gradient decay could be developed to help improve noise pollution and air quality.



Dr Ricky Mak, Senior Lecturer of the Division of Science, Engineering and Health Studies and Principal Investigator, aspires to improve noise and air pollution in Hong Kong.

科技、工程及健康學部高級講師及首席研究員麥榮朗博士期望改善香港的噪音及空氣污染問題。

「汽車懸浮粒子和噪音排放垂直分散模型」項目獲資助近港幣 100 萬元。

此項目將通過時間序列分析和晝夜分析，觀察和證明超細懸浮粒子核化情況的存在。此外，項目亦會收集不同地點的交通噪音測量值，以研究不同類型路面的降噪效能。數據會用來分析和探索顆粒物與噪音之間的關係，並發展模型去計算它們的垂直彌散率和垂直梯度衰減，有助改善城市噪音和空氣質素的問題。

With Dr Ding Hongdi, Lecturer of the Division of Languages and Communication, as the Principal Investigator, the project *The Interrogative Systems in Tibeto-Burman Languages of the Cool Mountain Area* obtained funding of over HK\$0.67 million.

This project aimed to describe the interrogative systems in Tibeto-Burman languages of the Cool Mountain area, Southwest China and identify the archaic and innovative features in these languages.



Dr Ding Hongdi, Principal Investigator, hopes that his research project can identify the archaic and innovative features in Tibeto-Burman languages of the Cool Mountain area.

The project *The Islamicate Soundscape of Hong Kong* obtained funding of about HK\$710,000.

This project aimed to study how members of different Muslim communities in Hong Kong used Islamicate sound to articulate and negotiate their own identities caught between their homeland, the diaspora community, the global Muslim community (Ummah), and Hong Kong, their adopted land. It would also discuss whether alternative strategies were adopted by them in presenting themselves sonically to a non-Muslim audience, and if yes, what were their strategies and intentions?

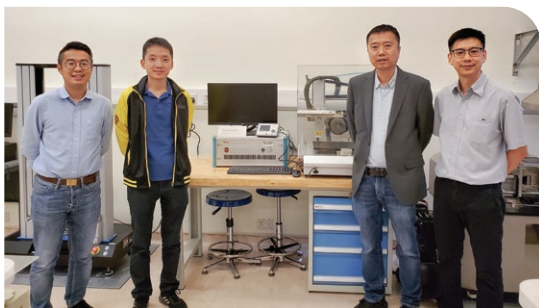

Self-financing Post-secondary Education Fund's Quality Enhancement Support Scheme (QESS)

HKCC received funding of HK\$2.4 million for launching the project *Development of a Web-based Remote Laboratory for Science and Engineering Education* to establish a remote lab at HKCC.

Through developing a web-based remote lab for science and engineering education, this project aimed to facilitate students' independent learning, enhance their learning experiences, and minimise the adverse effects resulting from the suspension of face-to-face laboratory sessions.

SPEED received funding of HK\$6.18 million to implement the project *Development of Virtual Reality (VR) Systems for Business and Tourism Education*.

This project, a collaboration between SPEED and HKCC, aimed to establish immersive VR systems with virtual and augmented reality simulations for all business and tourism students of SPEED and HKCC so as to make their learning more interactive.

SPEED 獲撥款港幣 618 萬元，推行「**建立虛擬現實系統予商業和旅遊業學生**」計劃。

Health and Medical Research Fund (HMRF)

醫療衛生研究基金

The project *Mechanistic Characterisation of the MT2-induced Pgp Inhibition and the Chemosensitization on Combining MT2 with Taxol in Treating Multi-drug Resistant Cancer in Vitro and in Vivo*, led by Dr Anthony Lui, Lecturer of the Division of Science, Engineering and Health Studies, secured funding about HK\$1 million. This was the first time that a CPCE scholar was granted funding by the HMRF of the Health Bureau.

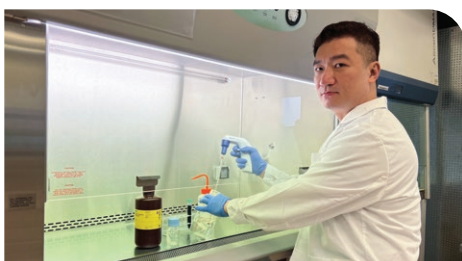
The project team has discovered a potent anti-cancer drug called MT2 from *Marsdenia Tenacissima*, a medicinal plant in Traditional Chinese Medicine. In this project, the anti-cancer drug mechanism of MT2 to inhibit multi-drug resistant Pgp protein would be elucidated by in vitro assays. Further, its anti-cancer effects would be demonstrated by various multi-drug resistant and non-resistant cancer cell models as well as in animal model. More importantly, synergistic anti-cancer effects would be demonstrated when MT2 could be co-treated with other chemotherapeutic agents, such as Taxol.

Its findings would prove that MT2 could be a novel and potent anti-cancer drug that is effective and safe for treating cancer patients in the future.

「**MT2 抑制 Pgp- 蛋白的作用機理及其在體內外增效紫杉醇對多藥耐藥腫瘤抑制效果的研究**」項目，由科技、工程及健康學部講師呂琪博士領導，獲撥款約港幣 100 萬元，是 CPCE 學者首次獲得醫務衛生局的醫療衛生研究基金資助進行研究。

項目團隊在傳統中藥的藥用植物通光藤之中，發現了一種強效抗癌藥物 MT2。此項目將通過體外實驗，闡明 MT2 抑制多重耐藥 Pgp 蛋白的抗癌藥物機制。此外，項目亦將以各種多藥耐藥和非耐藥細胞模型以及動物模型，展示 MT2 的抗癌作用。更重要的是可以展示 MT2 與其他化學治療劑（如紫杉醇）共同用於治療時的協同抗癌作用。

研究將證明 MT2 可以是一種新的強效抗癌藥物，未來可有效及安全地治療癌症患者。

The project *Effectiveness of Telehealth in Preventive Care: A Randomised Controlled Trial of Tele-exercise Programme Involving Elderly with Possible Sarcopenia or at Risk of Fall* secured funding around HK\$1.25 million.

There were some barriers for the elderly to maintain their exercise routine particularly under the pandemic. This project aimed to promote the tele-exercise approach to the elderly and evaluate their experience with tele-exercise quantitatively and qualitatively.

This project was led by Dr Karly Chan, Lecturer of the Division of Science, Engineering, and Health Studies (SEHS). Other team members included Prof. Peter Yuen, Dean of CPCE, Dr Ben Fong, Associate Division Head of the SEHS, Dr Vincent Law, Senior Lecturer of the Division of Social Sciences, Humanities and Design, Dr Fowie Ng, Associate Professor of Tung Wah College, and Dr Wilson Fung from Hong Kong Telemedicine Association.

項目「遠程醫療在預防保健中的有效性：遠程運動訓練計劃對患有肌少症或有跌倒風險的老年人的隨機對照試驗」獲撥款約港幣 125 萬元。

新冠肺炎疫情使到長者在維持定期鍛鍊體能方面遇上障礙。此項目旨在向長者推廣遠程鍛鍊方法，並以運動的質和量去評估長者的遠程鍛鍊體驗。

CPCE Health Conferences 2021 and 2022

CPCE 醫護研討會 2021 及 2022

Entitled "Long-term Care: Financing and Service Delivery in Asia-Pacific", the CPCE Health Conference 2022 was held in hybrid mode on 10 January 2022. Over 420 academics and experts from around the world participated in the Health Conference to share their views and expertise in critical issues related to an ever-increasing demand for long-term care caused by population ageing worldwide.

The Conference, held for the seventh consecutive year, was organised by the Centre for Ageing and Healthcare Management Research of SPEED in collaboration with the Hong Kong College of Community Health Practitioners, Hong Kong College of Health Service Executives, and Hong Kong College of Nursing and Health Care Management.

Besides, the CPCE Health Conference 2021 with the theme of "Post-pandemic Health and Long-term Care: A New Paradigm" was conducted on 20 September 2021 in hybrid mode. Over 400 experts and scholars were invited to participate; among them, more than 50 attended in person at the PolyU Hung Hom Bay Campus to share their insights into the long-term development of healthcare systems after the pandemic and put forward various ideas for promoting a healthcare reform.

2022 年度 CPCE 醫護研討會以「長期護理：在亞太區的融資及服務」為主題，於 2022 年 1 月 10 日以線上線下聯播形式舉行，邀請世界各地逾 420 名學者及專家參加，就全球人口老化引致長期護理服務需求與日俱增所造成的嚴重問題，分享意見及專業知識。

今年的研討會踏入第七屆，由 SPEED 轄下的老齡化和醫療管理研究中心主辦，合辦機構包括香港社區健康學院、香港醫務行政學院及香港護理及衛生管理學院。

另外，2021 年度 CPCE 醫護研討會於 2021 年 9 月 20 日以線上線下聯播形式舉行，逾 400 名專家及學者參加，其中 50 多名親臨理大紅磡灣校園現場，圍繞「疫情後醫護及長期護理的新局面」這個主題，分析疫後醫療護理的長遠發展方向，並提出各種構思，促進醫療改革。

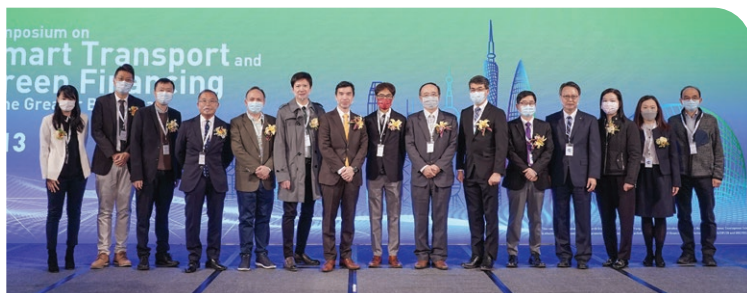
Symposium on Smart Transport and Green Financing in the Greater Bay Area 大灣區智慧交通與綠色金融研討會

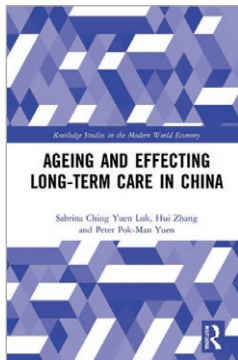

In addition, the authors discuss how the financing and delivery of LTC can be improved in China, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on older adults in need of LTC in that country and the implications of China's LTCI reform for other countries.

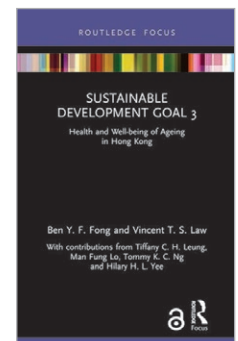
Sustainable Development Goal 3: Health and Well-being of Ageing in Hong Kong

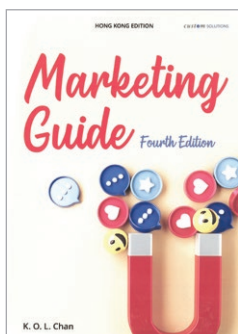
This book suggests that secondary care service may only be effective to a limited extent as a healthcare measure and an optimum healthcare system should be one that focuses on primary care.

Marketing Guide



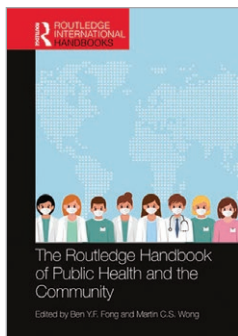

Establishment of CPCE Employability Services Office 成立 CPCE 就業服務處

Established in October 2021, the CPCE Employability Services Office (CESO) networks with domestic and global businesses to forge partnerships with the College, so as to provide employment opportunities for CPCE students.

CPCE 就業服務處 (CESO) 於 2021 年 10 月成立，協助學院與本地和環球企業建立夥伴關係，為 CPCE 畢業生提供就業機會。

CESO supports graduating students in seeking gainful employment through the provision of international industry related learning experiences, such as internships, career fairs and other activities conducive to students' employability.

In light of the growing importance of global exposure and employability in diverse work cultures, CESO organises Global-WIE programmes for students to equip them with global skills and vision for future career development.

Work-Integrated Education (WIE) and Internship Programmes

校企協作教育 (WIE) 及實習計劃

Aiming to equip students with work-based generic skills and hands-on experience essential to their career development, WIE provides workplace learning opportunities for students to learn and work in a real-life setting while at the same time contributing to different industries and the community.

Full-time students of SPEED's articulation honours degree programmes are required to complete 80-300 hours of WIE as part of their graduation requirements. At HKCC, WIE/placement is a mandatory component for HD students and an elective component for AD students. Scholarships and sponsorship are granted to students with outstanding performance in WIE.

In 2021/22, a total of 400 HKCC students participated in WIE/credit-based placement while 222 underwent non-credit-bearing internships. During the year, the CPCE Employability Services Office (CESO) collaborated with 48 enterprises through its WIE & Summer Placement Scholarship Programmes 2021 to offer students scholarships and internship opportunities.

Students participating in WIE can acquire work experience in different industries, including advertising and marketing, banking and finance, catering, hotel and tourism, healthcare, real estate and retail.

校企協作教育 (WIE) 旨在協助學生掌握投身任何工作均必須具備的通用技能，並為他們提供實踐的機會，從而為未來事業發展打穩基礎。WIE 讓學生可在真實環境下學習及工作，同時為各行各業及社區貢獻一己之力。

SPEED 榮譽學士學位銜接課程全日制學生須要完成 80-300 小時的 WIE，以符合畢業要求。HKCC 高級文憑課程學生必須修讀 WIE / 實習科目，而副學士課程學生則可選修這些科目。於 WIE 表現優秀的學生可獲頒獎學金和贊助金。

於 2021/22 學年，共有 400 位 HKCC 學生參加 WIE / 學分制實習，222 位 HKCC 學生參加非學分制實習計劃。同年，CPCE 就業服務處 (CESO) 與 48 間企業合作推行「校企協作教育及暑期實習獎學金計劃 2021」，為學生提供多項獎學金及實習機會。

參與實習的學生，可在不同行業汲取工作經驗，包括廣告及市場營銷、銀行及金融、餐飲、酒店及旅遊、健康護理、房地產及零售業。

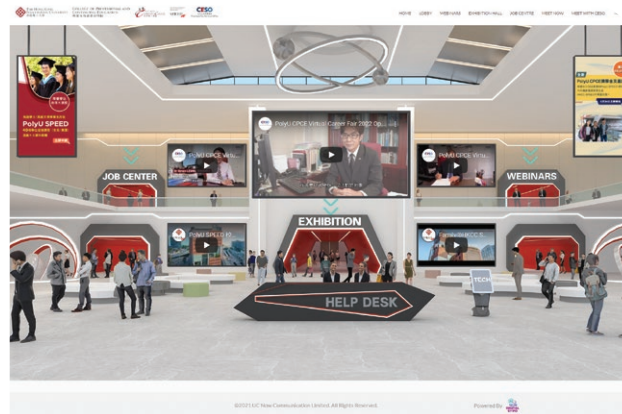

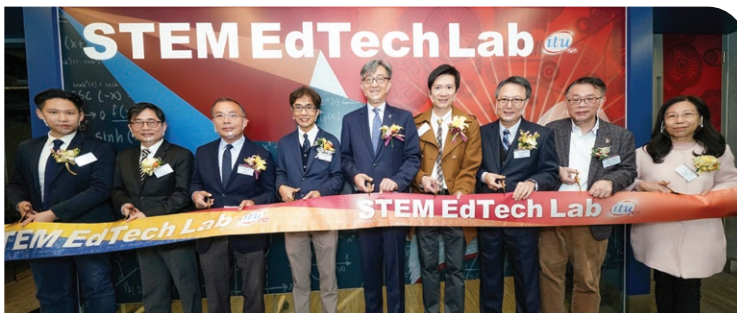
Establishment of STEM EdTech Lab 設立 STEM 教育科技實驗室

To better support the ongoing needs of hybrid teaching, enhancements were made by the Information Technology Unit in 2021/22. A number of 360 Cameras V2 were installed in all lecture theatres on the two campuses; the new version not only provides better facial identification but also the newly added vertical tracing function.

Besides, five classrooms on the two campuses were each equipped with a ceiling microphone to pick up students' voice in the classroom for sharing with students attending classes online, thereby facilitating discussions in a hybrid learning environment.

College Governance

學院管治

College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) is a self-financing college founded by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU). CPCE has its own Council which oversees the College's strategic directions and management.

Academic governance is overseen by the PolyU Senate, and the CPCE's College Board, which is a Senate Committee supervising matters relating to academic programmes of its constituent units, HKCC and SPEED.

The QA framework of CPCE, including its committee structure as well as the policy and procedures for its academic programmes, are governed by PolyU's regulations.

專業及持續教育學院 (CPCE) 是由香港理工大學 (理大) 成立的自資學院。學院設有本身的校董會，統籌學院的發展策略及管理。

學院的學術管治由理大教務委員會及 CPCE 學院院務委員會監督。學院院務委員會是教務委員會轄下的委員會，專責監督 CPCE 旗下的香港專上學院 (HKCC) 及專業進修學院 (SPEED) 的課程及相關事宜。

CPCE 的質素保證架構，包括委員會的組織，以及課程政策和程序，均按照理大的規則去治理和執行。

1. Governance Structure

1.1 Committee Structure and Management of CPCE

College Council

The College Council is the governing body of CPCE. Chaired by the PolyU President, its membership comprises Deputy President and Provost, Executive Vice President, Dean of CPCE, and the Director of Finance. Three Senate members of PolyU and three external members appointed by the University President also serve on the Council as members.

College Board

The College Board is responsible for the academic development of CPCE and quality assurance of its programmes and other activities. Chaired by Dean of CPCE, its membership includes staff from the academic divisions and student representatives from HKCC and SPEED.

Committees under the College Board

Under the College Board, there are a number of committees looking after various policy/functional areas. They are Academic Regulations Committee, Academic Appeals Committee, College Learning and Teaching Committee (CLTC), Course Assessing and Monitoring Committee, General University Requirements Committee, Research Committee, and Subjects Committee.

1. 管治架構

1.1 CPCE 委員會架構及管理

學校校董會

學校校董會是策劃及領導學院發展的管治組織，由理大校長擔任主席，成員包括常務及學務副校長、行政副校長、CPCE 院長，以及財務總監；其他成員包括三名理大教務委員會的成員，及三名由校長委任的校外人士。

學院院務委員會

學院院務委員會專責統籌學院的學術發展及質素保證等相關事宜，由 CPCE 院長擔任主席。委員會成員包括學部教員，以及 HKCC 和 SPEED 學生代表。

學院院務委員會轄下委員會

學院院務委員會轄下設有多個委員會，專責處理學院在不同範疇的政策或職能。它們包括教務規章委員會、教務申訴委員會、教學委員會、科目評核及監察委員會、核心課程委員會、研究委員會，以及科目委員會。

Dean of CPCE and various committees of the Dean

The Dean, as the chief executive of CPCE, is responsible to the Council and reports to the Deputy President and Provost for the management of the College. Committees of the Dean are set up to oversee various matters of the College, including campus and campus sustainability, ethics, management, human resources, information and education technology, grievances and appeals, student discipline, staff and student development, Work-Integrated Education, non-local affairs, library, student hostel management, catering services as well as health and safety.

CPCE Advisory Committee

The CPCE Advisory Committee offers advice on the strategic direction and development of the College. It also advises CPCE on the scope and nature of its academic programmes, research and other activities in relation to the needs of Hong Kong and the region. The majority of the CPCE Advisory Committee members, including the Chairman and Vice Chairman, are external to PolyU and CPCE.

1.2 CPCE Representations at PolyU Committees

CPCE is represented in various PolyU Committees. Dean of CPCE is a member of the Senate, the Academic Planning and Regulations Committee (APRC), the Quality Assurance Committee, and the Academic Council. The PolyU LTC (Learning and Teaching Committee) also includes two members representing CPCE, the CLTC Chair who serves as an ex-officio member, and another academic staff nominated by the College Board.

1.3 Communication with Staff and Students

Almost all CPCE committees include appointed, nominated or elected staff members to ensure that staff views are adequately represented in academic and other matters of the College. In addition, academic and non-academic staff representatives are elected to join the respective consultative groups which serve as an effective channel for collecting staff opinions in different College policies. The Staff Retreat also serves as a platform for colleagues to express their views and to be kept abreast of the latest College developments.

To ensure that students' voices are heard and they remain well-informed about CPCE's major developments, student representatives sit on a large number of College committees and user groups, such as College Board, College Learning and Teaching Committee, Library Committee, Information and Educational Technology Committee, Student Development Committee, Student Discipline Committee, Student Hostel Management Committee, Catering Committee and Campus User Groups. The composition of various committees at the Unit level also includes student members to facilitate student participation in the affairs of HKCC and SPEED.

CPCE 院長及院長轄下委員會

CPCE 院長向校董會負責，並向常務及學務副校長匯報學院管理事宜。院長轄下設有多個委員會，專責處理非教務政策事宜，包括校園事務、校園可持續發展、道德操守、管理、人力資源、資訊及教育科技、申訴及上訴、學生紀律、教職員和學生發展、校企協作教育計劃、非本地事務、圖書館、學生宿舍管理、膳食服務，以及健康及安全。

CPCE 顧問委員會

CPCE 顧問委員會就學院的策略方向和發展提供建議，亦會因應香港及地區的需要，為學院不同範疇及種類的學術課程、研究以至其他活動，提供意見。CPCE 顧問委員會的主席、副主席以至大部分成員都是校外成員，並非理大或 CPCE 人員。

1.2 理大轄下委員會的 CPCE 代表成員

理大轄下多個委員會均有 CPCE 的代表成員。CPCE 院長是教務委員會、教務策劃及規章委員會、質素委員會及學術政策委員會的成員。理大教學委員會亦有兩名 CPCE 成員，分別是學院教學委員會主席作為當然成員，以及由學院院務委員會提名的教員。

1.3 與教職員及學生的溝通

為確保學院在教學或其他事宜上，能夠充分反映及考慮員工意見，學院轄下的委員會大多有員工代表，他們經指派、提名或推選方式加入委員會。另外，CPCE 分別為教學人員和行政人員成立諮詢小組，教職員可以推選代表出任所屬小組的成員，讓學院在不同的決策上能夠廣納員工意見。此外，員工亦能夠藉著教職員退修會，掌握學院的最新動向，並對學院的發展發表意見。

為讓學生表達意見，以及了解學院的重要發展，學院多個委員會及小組均有學生代表成員，包括學院院務委員會、教學委員會、圖書館委員會、資訊及教育科技委員會、學生發展委員會、學生紀律委員會、學生宿舍管理委員會、膳食委員會以及校園用戶小組等。另外，HKCC 及 SPEED 轄下委員會亦包括學生成員，促進學生參與學院事務。

2. QA Framework

2.1 Programme Planning, Validation and Review Processes

All programmes leading to PolyU-SPEED awards at the undergraduate degree level go through programme planning, validation and review processes as prescribed by PolyU. For sub-degree programmes leading to PolyU-HKCC or PolyU-SPEED awards, planning approval is delegated by Senate to APRC (with the list of programmes approved presented to Senate for information), while implementation approval lies with Senate.

Approval authority for offering programmes/courses not leading to PolyU award is delegated by Senate to the CPCE College Board. For programmes offered in collaboration with overseas universities, the QA systems of the partner universities are duly followed.

For continuing education courses leading to qualifications which bear the PolyU name/logo, the approval authority is delegated by Senate to the CPCE College Board if the courses are to be offered by CPCE/SPEED.

2.2 Academic Advisor System

External Academic Advisors are appointed at CPCE on a broad discipline basis. In 2020/21, a total of seven Academic Advisors were appointed for the discipline areas of Business, Communication, Health and Life Sciences, Hotel and Tourism Management, Humanities and Design, Science and Engineering, and Social Sciences. The Academic Advisors give advice, in the relevant discipline, to CPCE Units and Divisions, in the areas of quality assurance; academic programmes and subjects; teaching, learning and assessment, etc.

2.3 Periodic Unit Review and Annual Programme Review

A Unit Review exercise is undertaken for HKCC and SPEED respectively on a six-year cycle basis. The Unit Review system serves as an instrument for quality enhancement in academic units; and as a major input for future strategic planning, visioning and international benchmarking. A Review Panel, chaired by Dean(PCE) (who also serves as the College Board Chairman), will be formed. Review Panel members will include at least two ad hoc Independent Advisors for the Unit Review to be conducted on a Unit basis, or a minimum of three ad hoc Independent Advisors for the Unit Review to be conducted on CPCE basis, a PolyU internal academic member, and other members if deemed necessary. In addition, a member of PolyU Academic Registry will be appointed as an observer with no voting right to the Panel.

2. 質素保證架構

2.1 課程策劃、評審及檢討程序

所有可獲頒理大專業進修學院學銜的學士學位課程都必須經過課程策劃、評審及檢討程序，這些程序由理大明確規定，所有學院必須依循。至於所有可頒授理大香港專上學院或理大專業進修學院學銜的副學位課程，教務委員會授權教務策劃及規章委員會進行策劃審批（獲審批課程列表提交給教務委員會作參考），其後課程亦須獲教務委員會通過，方可開辦。

另外，在提供其他非頒授理大學銜的課程 / 科目方面，教務委員會授權 CPCE 學院院務委員會予以審批。學院與海外大學合辦的課程，會依循該大學的質素保證機制。

在持續進修課程方面，若課程頒授的資歷證明印有理大名稱 / 校徽，並且由 CPCE/SPEED 開辦，教務委員會授權 CPCE 學院院務委員會予以審批。

2.2 學術顧問制度

CPCE 就不同學術範疇委任校外學術顧問。2020/21 年度，學院就工商管理、傳意、健康及生命科學、酒店及旅遊業管理、人文及設計學、科技及工程，以及社會科學等學術範疇，委任了七名學術顧問。他們因應各自的學術範疇，向 CPCE 轄下學院和學部提供意見，建議範圍涵蓋質素保證、課程和科目、教學和評估等。

2.3 定期部門檢視及年度課程檢討

HKCC 和 SPEED 需要每六年進行一次部門檢視。這個部門檢視制度可以促使學院提升質素；並為部門未來的策略和遠景規劃，以及國際基準引入專業意見。部門檢視小組將由 CPCE 院長（即學院院務委員會主席）擔任主席，進行教學單位（即 HKCC 或 SPEED）的個別部門檢視將包括不少於兩名臨時聘任的獨立顧問；若進行 CPCE（同時包括 HKCC 及 SPEED）的綜合部門檢視則需要最少三名臨時聘任的獨立顧問。另外，部門檢視小組亦包括一名理大校內教員，並按需要加入其他成員，同時委任一名理大教務處成員為不具投票權的觀察員。

HKCC and SPEED also undertake annual programme reviews so as to maintain high academic standards and to ensure that the programmes best suit the learning needs and interests of students. Feedback is obtained from various stakeholders, including students, employers and partner organisations.

HKCC and SPEED are required to submit Annual Programme Review (APR) reports, by the end of November each year, to the CPCE College Board for approval. The APR reports allow the Units to review the programme data and reflect on the academic standards, academic quality, operation and continuing relevance of the programmes. The Units will also identify the strengths and weaknesses of the programmes or any other issues that may need attention, and devise strategies to build on strengths, remedy weaknesses and address issues of concern. Based on the observations on the APR reports, the College Board will advise HKCC and SPEED on improvement action as and where necessary and appropriate.

2.4 Other Channels of External Input to QA System

Other channels of external input to CPCE QA System include appointments of external members from both academic and industrial sectors to the CPCE Advisory Committee; external examiners/advisors for individual programmes; external members on programme validation panels. Furthermore, academic programmes are accredited by professional bodies where appropriate.

In addition, to assure the quality of education offered, the operations and programmes of HKCC and SPEED are subject to external review by the Quality Assurance Council (QAC) of the University Grants Committee (UGC).

HKCC 和 SPEED 每年均為課程進行檢討，以確保課程質素優良，並且切合學生的學習需要和興趣。兩所學院亦會諮詢學生、僱主及合作團體等持份者的意見。

另外，HKCC 及 SPEED 須於每年十一月底前向學院院務委員會提交年度課程檢討報告，藉此審視課程數據，以及檢討學術水平、學術質素、課程運作及其持續相關性。教學單位也會找出課程的強項和不足之處，或任何需要重視的問題，然後制訂策略，以鞏固強項，改善不足之處，以及處理值得關注的問題。學院院務委員會會根據年度課程檢討報告的內容提供意見，或建議 HKCC 及 SPEED 採取適當的跟進措施。

2.4 外界參與質素保證機制的其他途徑

外界參與 CPCE 質素保證機制的其他途徑包括委任學術界及業界人士擔任 CPCE 顧問委員會校外成員；個別課程委任校外主考/顧問；委任校外人士擔任課程評審委員會成員。此外，學術課程會按實際需要，尋求專業團體認可。

另外，HKCC 及 SPEED 的運作及課程均需接受大學教育資助委員會轄下質素保證局的質素核證，以確保教育質素。

Overview

概述

The College of Professional and Continuing Education (CPCE) is one of the largest self-financing providers of full-time tertiary education in Hong Kong. As an independent self-financed arm of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU), CPCE offers programmes through two subsidiaries of PolyU, namely Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) and College of Professional and Continuing Education Limited (CPCE Limited). The latter encompasses the School of Professional Education and Executive Development (SPEED), academic divisions and various supporting offices. In the 2021/22 academic year, HKCC and SPEED provided quality tertiary education to around 11,000 full-time students by offering mainly sub-degree and articulation honours degree programmes. In addition, CPCE also offered a wide range of continuing education programmes to cater for the different needs and demands of the community.

With the continual decline in the HKDSE school candidate population and the economic uncertainty induced by the prolonged COVID-19 pandemic, players of the self-financing tertiary education sector inevitably continued to face great challenges in terms of student admission and finance position. Staying focused in the provision of high-quality education and effective management of costs and risks, CPCE's financial performance in 2021/22 remained healthy, with an operating surplus of \$78.1 million (2020/21: \$49.4 million). The net surplus of CPCE for 2021/22 was \$48.1 million (2020/21: \$29.4 million), after making a contribution of \$30 million (2020/21: \$20 million) to PolyU for general educational purposes in furtherance of the objects of both CPCE and PolyU. As at 30 June 2022, the net asset value of CPCE was \$631.4 million (2020/21: \$583.3 million).

專業及持續教育學院（以下簡稱「學院」）為香港最具規模的全日制自資專上教育機構之一。學院是由香港理工大學（以下簡稱「理大」）成立的獨立自資學院，透過香港專上學院及專業及持續教育學院有限公司兩間理大的附屬公司提供課程。後者由專業進修學院、學部和行政部門所組成。在 2021/22 學年，香港專上學院及專業進修學院主要開辦副學位及榮譽學士學位銜接課程，為約 11,000 名全日制學生提供優質的專上教育。另外，學院亦一如既往地，提供涵蓋不同範疇的持續進修課程，配合社會的不同需求。

隨著香港中學文憑考試考生人數持續下降，以及 2019 新型冠狀病毒疫情持續，導致經濟不明朗，自資專上院校不可避免地繼續在招生和財務狀況方面面臨巨大挑戰。學院專注於提供優質教育和有效管理成本和風險，2021/22 年度的財務表現仍然保持穩健，營運盈餘為 7,810 萬港元（2020/21：4,940 萬港元）。扣除學院給予理大的 3,000 萬港元（2020/21：2,000 萬港元）供款，用作一般教育用途，以促進學院與理大的教學宗旨，學院本年的淨盈餘為 4,810 萬港元（2020/21：2,940 萬港元）。截至 2022 年 6 月 30 日，學院的淨資產價值為 6.314 億港元（2020/21：5.833 億港元）。

Operating Results and Financial Position

營運結果及財務狀況

In 2021/22, the total income for CPCE (including HKCC and SPEED) was \$844.8 million (2020/21: \$840.3 million) and the total operating expenditure was \$766.7 million (2020/21: \$790.9 million), resulting in an operating surplus of \$78.1 million for the year (2020/21: \$49.4 million).

在 2021/22 年度，學院（包括香港專上學院及專業進修學院）的總營運收入為 8.448 億港元（2020/21：8.403 億港元），而總營運開支為 7.667 億港元（2020/21：7.909 億港元）。年內學院錄得營運盈餘 7,810 萬港元（2020/21：4,940 萬港元）。

HKCC

The income of HKCC in 2021/22 was \$578.2 million (2020/21: \$571.5 million), representing a net increase of \$6.7 million mainly due to an increase of the tuition fee. On the expenditure side, a total of \$507.5 million was incurred during the year (2020/21: \$518.6 million). With the completion of some large repair and maintenance as well as campus enhancement projects during 2020/21, the expenditure for the year was decreased by \$11.1 million as compared to that of 2020/21.

香港專上學院

香港專上學院於 2021/22 年度的收入為 5.782 億港元（2020/21：5.715 億港元），較去年上升了 670 萬港元，主要原因是學費增加。在支出方面，年內的總營運開支為 5.075 億港元（2020/21：5.186 億港元）。由於在 2020/21 年度完成了一些大型維修保養和校園優化工程，本年度的總營運開支較去年減少了 1,110 萬港元。

SPEED

The income of SPEED in 2021/22 was \$266.6 million (2020/21: \$268.8 million), representing a net decrease of \$2.2 million. The decrease was mainly the result of lower student enrolments for overseas academic award programmes and the gradual phasing out of the franchising arrangement for PolyU award self-financed articulation honours degree programmes. On the expenditure side, SPEED recorded a total operating expenditure of \$259.2 million in 2021/22 (2020/21: \$272.3 million), representing a decrease of \$13.1 million, principally due to the reduction of its operating cost in tandem with lower student enrolments.

專業進修學院

專業進修學院於 2021/22 年度的收入為 2.666 億港元（2020/21：2.688 億港元），較去年減少了 220 萬港元，主要原因是海外大學學銜課程的學生人數下降，以及正在逐步取消理大的自資榮譽學士學位銜接課程的特許經營安排。在支出方面，專業進修學院於 2021/22 年度的總營運開支為 2.592 億港元（2020/21：2.723 億港元），較去年減少了 1,310 萬港元，主要原因是學生人數下降，營運成本相應減低。

Financial Outlook

財政展望

CPCE is confident in its long-term financial sustainability and will continue to commit itself to delivering a healthy financial performance through a robust and comprehensive operation model embedded with sound and credible plans as well as prudent cost control measures.

It is foreseeable that major challenges remain for the self-financing tertiary education sector, including the ongoing admission challenges due to the continual decline in the HKDSE school candidate population and the continuing support of UGC-funded senior year places. Nonetheless, CPCE will continue to stay focused to confront the challenges with the adoption of a two-pronged approach of maintaining a steady stream of income and controlling the overall cost base through the provision of quality programmes that can meet societal needs, and proper management of the cost base by prioritising spending.

Scenario planning continues to play a key role in financial planning. The multi-year financial budget, together with scenario analysis, serves as a framework for achieving new levels of excellence and places CPCE on a sustainable path to accomplish its mission and realise its vision. To support the strategic objectives and priorities of CPCE, the budget is prepared on a realistic basis with sensitivity assessment, encompassing the main assumptions as well as the potential risks arising from external and governmental factors. The guiding principles for the budget include the effective management on allocation of its resources and accumulated surplus among students, staff and campus facilities in order to enhance the quality of education for the benefit of the students while ensuring the long-term financial sustainability of CPCE.

Besides the multi-year financial budget, CPCE has set aside various reserves for major renovation and maintenance of the two campuses, as a contingency for maintaining smooth operations in the event of unexpected adverse financial circumstances, and special requirements for other developmental initiatives.

學院對其長期財務可持續性充滿信心，並將繼續致力以穩健務實的計劃和審慎的成本監控，實踐健全的營運模式，取得穩健的財務表現。

可預見自資專上教育界別仍然面臨種種重大挑戰，包括香港中學文憑考試考生人數持續下降以及教資會資助高年級學士學位的持續支持而導致的收生挑戰。儘管如此，學院將繼續專注及積極迎接這些挑戰，通過雙管齊下的方法來保持穩定的收入和控制整體成本，包括提供可以滿足社會需求的高質素課程，以及訂立支出的優先次序來適當管理和控制成本。

方案規劃將繼續在財務規劃上發揮關鍵作用。多個財政年度的預算連同方案分析，成為實現卓越水平的框架，使學院走上可持續發展的道路，以實現其使命和抱負。為了支持學院的策略目標和重點，財政預算以實況為基礎，並且評估了不同的變數對預算的影響，包括重要因素的假設，以及外在和政府因素可能帶來的風險。財政預算所採取的原則，是把學院的資源和累積盈餘有效地管理和適當地投放於學生、教職員和校園設施三方面，藉此提高教學質素，使學生有所裨益，並確保學院的長期財務可持續性得以維持。

除了制定多個財政年度的預算之外，學院還預留各項儲備作為兩所校園的大型翻新和維修，以及在財政不利的情況下能夠維持平穩運作和為日後其他發展項目作應急之用。
