

Nearly 70 Long Serving Staff Honoured at CPCE

On 10 January 2018, CPCE held the Long Service Award Presentation Ceremony 2017 to honour staff members who have served for 10 years in CPCE, including its educational units of HKCC and SPEED. Prof. Peter Yuen, Dean of CPCE, presented the awards to 69 long-serving colleagues in recognition of their dedication and contributions to the College.

The Ceremony culminated with the appearance on stage of Prof. Yuen, together with Dr Peter Walters, Consultant to Dean, as the awardees this time instead of the award presenters as colleagues had used to see.

“There were different stages of development in the local self-financing tertiary education sector in the past decade. I am glad to have sailed through thick and thin with our committed colleagues, and witnessed the great strides CPCE has made in the provision of quality higher education opportunities,” said Prof. Yuen, who shared his feelings on receiving the award.
