Construction is a demanding industry, pushing all of its workers through long, irregular hours. Those who want to advance their careers are often unable to find enough time for classroom learning, which is why Mak Chi Kong chose HKCyberU to gain an MSc in Project Management. 
Having committed himself to the programme, Mr Mak understood that he needed to devote a lot of efforts in order to obtain a Master's degree qualification.

at his alma mater, Mr Mak circles back to the importance of self discipline, adding that good time management is also crucial to "working through the material" consistently. The reward, he says, will be "a new experience of learning."
