CPCE Associate Dean (QA) — Leading with a People-focused Philosophy

On the wall inside the office of Prof. Warren Chiu, Associate Dean (Quality Assurance) of CPCE, a painting in rich, earthy colours brings a sense of tranquility. The painting is fulfilling an important purpose - the creator of this soothing landscape, Prof. Chiu himself, is enjoying it every day.

"I love painting," said Prof. Chiu, who also enjoys sharing his passion for painting with colleagues. The process of building something from scratch, then perfecting and appraising it, is a creative journey. Since joining CPCE in late August 2016, Prof. Chiu has started channeling his creativeness to the College's development.

At CPCE, Prof. Chiu oversees areas of work including quality assurance of academic programmes, staffing, research as well as marketing and branding. He views that these important roles have given him many opportunities to get creative. "Academic programme design is an area where creativity can be employed. We have to be creative and flexible, and make timely adjustments to ensure that our programmes stay relevant to market trends," he said.

Managing such a wide spectrum of responsibilities requires sound leadership. Incidentally, leadership is one of Prof. Chiu's longtime research interests. He publishes papers on leadership, organisational behaviour, employee wellbeing and other human resource management issues. With his doctoral degree directed towards industrial and organisational psychology, it is no wonder that when asked about his management philosophy, Prof. Chiu gave one simple answer: "People".

"People are often called a top asset to corporations and societies," Prof. Chiu agrees, but he offers a deeper perspective: "Management is about getting jobs done through other people. However, the key here isn't just about delegation. People must be respected, treasured, and listened to."

Believing that positive workplace relationships breed progress, Prof. Chiu came up with new plans to build connections among staff. Items on his agenda include fostering a research culture, as well as facilitating social bonding and scholarly exchange among academics.

趙教授在學院的管轄範疇包括:學術課程 的質素保證、人力資源、學術研究、市場 推廣及品牌管理。這些重任帶來不少發揮 創意的機會,趙教授表示:「設計學術課 程時,需要運用靈活創意,對課程作出適 時的調整,才能夠緊貼市場的發展。」

要管理範圍廣泛的工作,便需要良好的領 導才能。領導能力恰巧是趙教授向來熱衷 的研究範疇。他的研究論文涵蓋領導能 力、組織行為、員工福祉以至其他人力資 源範疇;由於趙教授以研究工業及組織心 理學為博士論文,因此被問及其管理哲學 時,他扼要地回答:「人」。

「人往往被視為企業和社會最重要的資 產。」趙教授不但贊同此觀點,而且有更 深入的看法。「管理是透過眾人的力量, 把工作辦妥。可是,員工獲委以任務後, 更需要獲得尊重、肯定,並希望意見受到 關注。」

趙教授相信,正向的工作關係是進步的原 動力,故此他希望以新舉措加強員工關 係,包括推動教員的研究文化,並促進社 交聯繫及學術交流。
